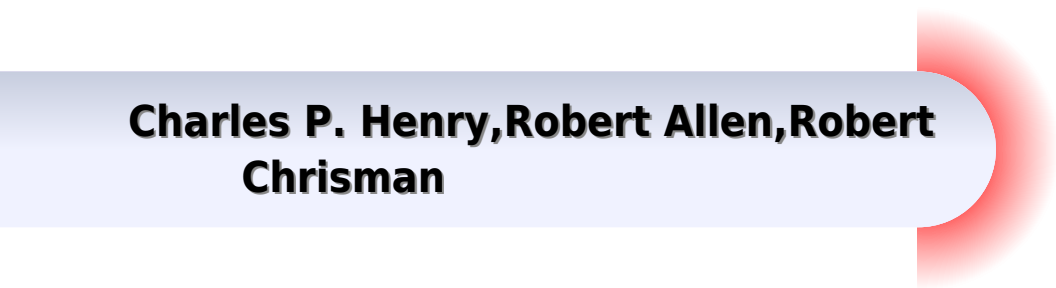

**The Crusade for Equality in the Workplace** Robert Belton, 2014-04-14 On March 8 1971 the Supreme Court of the United States decided a case Griggs v Duke Power Co brought by thirteen African American employees who worked as common laborers and janitors at one of Duke Power s facilities The decision in plaintiffs favor marked a profound and enduring challenge to the dominance of white males in the workplace In this book Robert Belton who represented the plaintiffs for the NAACP Legal Defense Fund and argued the case in the lower courts gives a firsthand account of legal history in the making and a behind the scenes look at the highly complex process of putting civil rights law to work Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 eliminated much blatant discrimination but after its enactment and before Griggs businesses held the view that a commitment to equality required only eliminating policies and practices that were intentionally discriminatory the disparate treatment test In Griggs v Duke Power Co the Supreme Court ruled that a disparate impact test could also apply that the 1964 Civil Rights Act extended to practices with a discriminatory effect In tracing the impact of the Griggs ruling on employment practices this book documents the birth maturation death and rebirth of the disparate impact theory including its erosion by later Supreme Court decisions and its restoration by congressional action in the Civil Rights Act of 1991 Belton conducts us through this historic case from the original lawsuit to the Supreme Court decision in Griggs and beyond as he traces the post Griggs developments in the lower courts the Supreme Court and Congress he provides informed insights into both litigators and judges perspectives and decision making His work situates the case in its legal social and historical contexts and explores the relationship between public and private enforcement of the law with a focus on the Legal Defense Fund s litigation campaign against employment discrimination A detailed examination of the development of legal principles under Title VII this book tells the story of this seminal decision on equal employment law and offers an unprecedented close up view of personal conviction legal strategy and historical forces combining to effect dramatic social change

He discovers that due to structural factors, social and class positions, and past experiences, resources are not valued equally among families, and even when deemed valuable, financial factors and issues of opportunity hoarding often prevent certain RAPS families from accessing that resource. In addition to its fresh and incisive insights into educational inequality, this groundbreaking book also presents valuable policy-oriented solutions for administrators, teachers, activists, and politicians.

**Dog Whistle Politics** Ian Haney-Lopez, 2014-02 The decades-long increase in income inequality has become perhaps the issue in American politics, and scholars have offered many reasons for why the gap between the rich and the rest has widened so much since the mid-1970s. Most of the explanations have been social and political in the broadest sense, and many have keyed on the propensity of middle and working-class Americans to vote against their own interest. Yet given that the greatest income divide is racial in nature, why have so few looked toward racially motivated behavior as a cause? *Dog Whistle Politics: How Coded Racial Appeals Have Wrecked the Middle Class* is a sweeping account of how dog whistle racial politics contributed to increasing inequality in America since the 1960s. Now a pervasive term in American political coverage, dog whistle refers to coded signals sent to certain constituencies that only those constituencies will understand. Just as only dogs can hear a dog whistle, only a constituency fluent in a subterranean argot can understand that argot when it is used. For instance, attacks on Obama's use of a teleprompter is a dog whistle for racist voters who question blacks, and by extension, the President's intelligence. Haney's book will cover racial dog whistles in America from the 1960s to the present, showing that their appeal has helped generate working-class and middle-class populist enthusiasm for policies that were actually injurious to their own interests. As Haney Lopez argues, the implicit association between blacks and social welfare programs that dog whistle politicians make has led many voters to turn against the state itself despite the fact that they benefit from redistributive policies. The dog whistle tactic has been with us from at least the era of George Wallace, but every candidate who has benefited from race-based resentments has used it. Nixon, Reagan, welfare queens, George Bush, I, Willie Horton, Bill Clinton, Sister Souljah, and most recently, Newt Gingrich. A sweeping reinterpretation of the recent political and legal history of the U.S., *Dog Whistle Politics* is sure to generate a productive and lively debate about the role of race as a fundamental driver of inequality.

**To Right These Wrongs** Robert R. Korstad, James L. Leloudis, 2011-01-20 When Governor Terry Sanford established the North Carolina Fund in 1963, he saw it as a way to provide a better life for the tens of thousands whose family income is so low that daily subsistence is always in doubt. Illustrated with evocative photographs by Billy Barnes, *To Right These Wrongs* offers a lively

account of this pioneering effort in America's War on Poverty Robert Korstad and James Leloudis describe how the Fund's initial successes grew out of its reliance on private philanthropy and federal dollars and its commitment to the democratic mobilization of the poor Both were calculated tactics designed to outflank conservative state lawmakers and entrenched local interests that nourished Jim Crow perpetuated one party politics and protected an economy built on cheap labor By late 1968 when the Fund closed its doors a resurgent politics of race had gained the advantage led by a Republican Party that had reorganized itself around opposition to civil rights and aid to the poor The North Carolina Fund came up short in its battle against poverty but its story continues to be a source of inspiration and instruction for new generations of Americans
