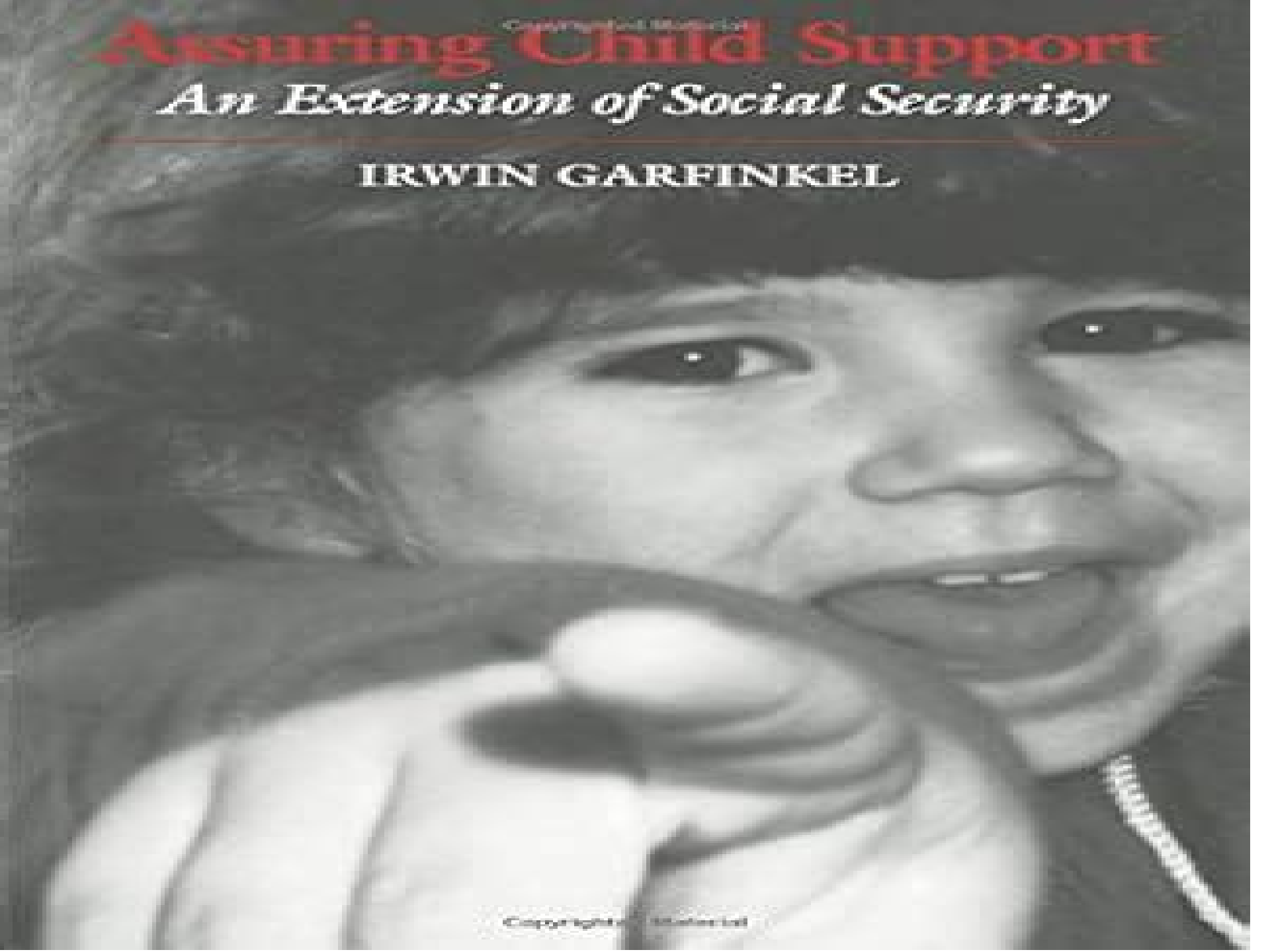

Blank, Ron Haskins, 2004-05-13 Congress must reauthorize the sweeping 1996 welfare reform legislation by October 1 2002 A number of issues that were prominent in the 1995 96 battle over welfare reform are likely to resurface in the debate over reauthorization Among those issues are the five year time limit provisions to reduce out of wedlock births the adequacy of child care funding problems with Medicaid and food stamp receipt by working families and work requirements Funding levels are also certain to be controversial Fiscal conservatives will try to lower grant spending levels while states will seek to maintain them and gain additional discretion in the use of funds Finally a movement to encourage states to promote marriage among low income families is already taking shape The need for reauthorization presents an opportunity to assess what welfare reform has accomplished and what remains to be done The New World of Welfare is an attempt to frame the policy debate for reauthorization and to inform the policy discussion among the states and at the federal level especially by drawing lessons from research on the effects of welfare reform In the book a diverse set of welfare experts liberal and conservative academic and nonacademic engage in rigorous debate on topics ranging from work experience programs to job availability to child well being to family formation In order to provide a comprehensive overview of the current state of research on welfare reform the contributors cover subjects including work and wages effects of reform on family income and poverty the politics of conservative welfare reform sanctions and time limits financial work incentives for low wage earners the use of Medicaid and food stamps welfare to work child support child care and welfare reform and immigration Preparation of the volume was supported by funds from the Annie E Casey Foundation and the Charles Stewart Mott Foundation Ending Welfare as We Know It R. Kent Weaver, 2000-08-01 Bill Clinton's first presidential term was a period of extraordinary change in policy toward low income families In 1993 Congress enacted a major expansion of the Earned Income Tax Credit for low income working families In 1996 Congress passed and the president signed the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act This legislation abolished the sixty year old Aid to Families with Dependent Children AFDC program and replaced it with a block grant program Temporary Assistance for Needy Families It contained stiff new work requirements and limits on the length of time people could receive welfare benefits Dramatic change in AFDC was also occurring piecemeal in the states during these years States used waivers granted by the federal Department of Health and Human Services to experiment with a variety of welfare strategies including denial of additional benefits for children born or conceived while a mother received AFDC work requirements and time limits on receipt of cash benefits The pace of change

at the state level accelerated after the 1996 federal welfare reform legislation gave states increased leeway to design their programs Ending Welfare as We Know It analyzes how these changes in the AFDC program came about In fourteen chapters R Kent Weaver addresses three sets of questions about the politics of welfare reform the dismal history of comprehensive AFDC reform initiatives the dramatic changes in the welfare reform agenda over the past thirty years and the reasons why comprehensive welfare reform at the national level succeeded in 1996 after failing in 1995 in 1993 94 and on many previous occasions Welfare reform raises issues of race class and sex that are as difficult and divisive as any in American politics While broad social and political trends helped to create a historic opening for welfare reform in the late 1990s dramatic legislation was not inevitable The interaction of contextual factors with short

Bergmann,1996-10-24 More than one in five American children live below the poverty line a proportion that exceeds that of any other advanced nation Although large numbers of Western European children live with single or unemployed parents or belong to disadvantaged minorities they are better shielded from severe deprivation by carefully designed public assistance programs Saving Our Children from Poverty describes one of the most successful European systems of assistance for families that of France and through comparison with American programs offers a valuable guide to improving our own safety net for children and reforming our dysfunctional welfare system Saving Our Children from Poverty details the array of benefits available to both high and low income families in France Government run nursery schools provide free high quality care for almost all children between the ages of three and six Children also receive guaranteed medical care under a national health insurance plan The French system offers married couples most of the same benefits as single parents and creates strong incentives to seek and hold jobs rather than remain on welfare A French single mother who chooses to work still receives substantial income supplements housing assistance subsidized health care and access to public child care facilities In stark contrast her American counterpart loses most of her cash benefits if she takes a job and receives no government assistance with child care Because American policies focus disproportionately on aiding the poorest non working families parents forced to rely on low wage jobs are frequently left without the resources to provide their children with an adequate standard of living As the public debate on welfare reform continues to rage ever more American children fall into poverty Why does the nation remain so unresponsive to their plight Saving Our Children from Poverty probes the American aversion to national assistance programs citing the negative attitudes that have seeped into the current political discourse A lack of faith in the federal government s administrative abilities has bolstered a trend toward decentralization of programs as well as a growing resistance to taxation Racial antipathies and a belief that financial support
