Australian Colonial Art 1800 19:

Representing the Past in the Art of the Long Nineteenth Century Matthew C. Potter, 2021-09-30 This edited collection explores the intersection of historical studies and the artistic representation of the past in the long nineteenth century The case studies provide not just an account of the pursuit of history in art within Western Europe but also examples from beyond that sphere These cover canonical and conventional examples of history painting as well as more inclusive popular and vernacular visual cultural phenomena General themes explored include the problematics internal to the theory and practice of academic history painting and historical genre painting including compositional devices and the authenticity of artefacts depicted relationships of power and purpose in historical art the use of historical art for alternative Liberal and authoritarian ideals the international cross fertilisation of ideas about historical art and exploration of the diverse influences of socioeconomic and geopolitical factors This book will be of particular interest to scholars of the histories of nineteenth century art and culture

Colonial frontiers Lynette Russell, 2017-03-01 Cross cultural encounters produce boundaries and frontiers This book explores the formation structure and maintenance of boundaries and frontiers in settler colonies The southern nations of Australia New Zealand and South Africa have a common military heritage as all three united to fight for the British Empire during the Boer and First World Wars The book focuses on the southern latitudes and especially Australia and Australian historiography Looking at cross cultural interactions in the settler colonies the book illuminates the formation of new boundaries and the interaction between settler societies and indigenous groups It contends that the frontier zone is a hybrid space a place where both indigene and invader come together on land that each one believes to be their own The best way to approach the northern Cape frontier zone is via an understanding of the significance of the frontier in South African history The book explores some ways in which discourses of a natural prehistoric Aboriginality inform colonial representations of the Australian landscape and its inhabitants both indigenous and immigrant The missions of the London Missionary Society LMS in Polynesia and Australia are examined to explore the ways in which frontiers between British and antipodean cultures were negotiated in colonial textuality The role of the Treaty of Waitangi in New Zealand society is possibly the most important and controversial issue facing modern New Zealanders The book also presents valuable insights into sexual politics Aboriginal sovereignty economics of Torres Strait maritime and nomadism

Rethinking settler colonialism Annie Coombes, 2017-03-01 Rethinking settler colonialism focuses on the long history of contact between indigenous peoples and the white colonial communities who settled in Australia Aotearoa New Zealand Canada and South Africa It interrogates how histories of colonial settlement have been mythologised narrated and embodied in public culture in the twentieth century through monuments exhibitions and images and charts some of the vociferous challenges to such histories that have emerged over recent years Despite a shared familiarity with cultural and political institutions practices and policies amongst the white settler communities the distinctiveness which marked these constituencies as variously Australian South African Canadian or New Zealander was fundamentally contingent upon their relationship to and with the various indigenous communities they encountered In each of these countries these communities were displaced marginalised and sometimes subjected to attempted genocide through

the colonial process Recently these groups have renewed their claims for greater political representation and autonomy The essays and artwork in this book insist that an understanding of the political and cultural institutions and practices which shaped settler colonial societies in the past can provide important insights into how this legacy of unequal rights can be contested in the present It will be of interest to those studying the effects of colonial powers on indigenous populations and the legacies of imperial rule in postcolonial societies

Upside Down World Penny Olsen, 2010 Late eighteenth and early nineteenth century Eurocentric perceptions of natural history led to the flora and fauna of the new colony of New South Wales being viewed as deficient and inferior The swans of the colony were black and eagles white birds built shell strewn avenues of sticks to cavort in and parrots walked on the ground The mammals carried their young in a pouch and there were furred animals that laid eggs This miscellany of the curious fuelled the rage for Australian natural history amongst the upper classes of Europe bringing income and occasionally fame to its collectors and documenters On the ground in the colony it contributed to great change for the animals and in some cases extinction In *Upside Down World* author Penny Olsen documents how our scientific knowledge evolved using collectors and naturalists journals to enhance her stories
