in general and bird navigation in particular has produced a literature of impressive proportions the threads provided by the plethora of research papers review articles and symposiums volumes have not yet been knitted into a theoretical fabric This is partly due to our still incomplete understanding of fundamental topics in avian navigation The answer to the most intriguing question of how a bird displaced to unknown territory finds its way back home is as obscure now as it was a few decades ago Whether and how birds solve this problem by using far ranging grid maps or more local familiar area maps as has been proposed off and on is still a matter of heated debates These debates frequently center around provocative hypotheses let alone the question about the physical topographic magnetic infrasonic olfactory parameters which might constitute such maps
