Bishop Aethelwold Barbara Yorke, 1997 thelwold was a major figure in the ecclesiastical and political life of 10th century England This much need appraisal of his life and work views him as monastic reformer scholar and teacher Æthelwold, His Followers, and Saints' Cults in Early Medieval England Alison Hudson, 2022 An exploration of how thelwold and those he influenced deployed the promotion of saints to implement religious reform Bishop thelwold of Winchester and his associates were some of the most radical monastic reformers in tenth century Europe In two generations they took over most of the powerful churches in the kingdom of England and implemented a number of the policies found in their ambitious monastic manifestos.
