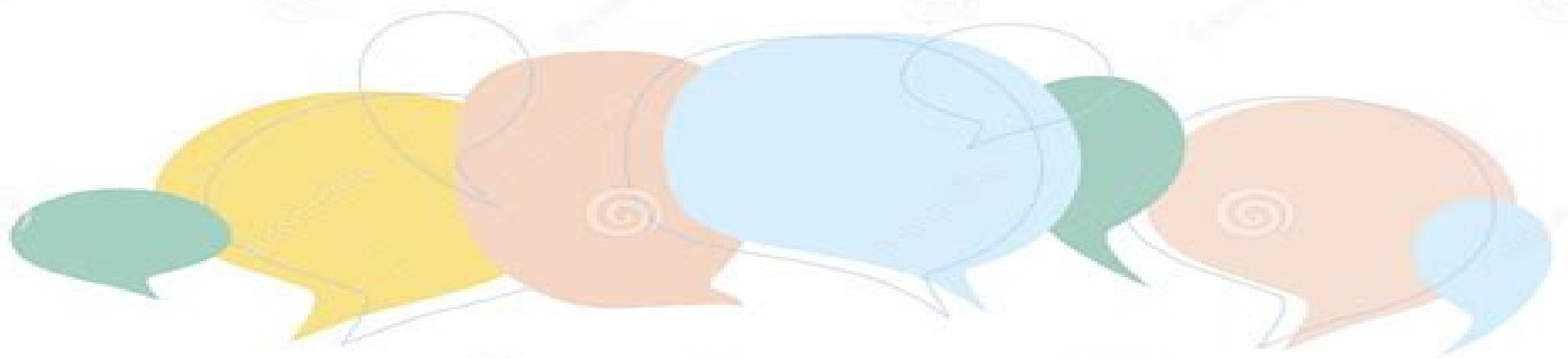

northern colonial experience and to the founding of the United States
