Zima, 2012-12-06 In October 1972 our Czech written book Literatury eerne Afriky Literatures of Black Mrica was published in Prague presenting a survey of an extensive field The publication which was signed at that time by all three authors differed from most contemporary introductions to the study of Mrican literatures in a threefold way a The authors attempted to cover various literacy and literary efforts in the area roughly delimited by Senegal in the west Kenya in the east Lake Chad in the north and the Cape in the south We were well aware even at that time that neither technically nor linguistically would it be possible to cover all literary efforts within that area We did try however to include in our survey both the literacies and literatures written in the Indo European linguae francae
