Black Artists in Their Own Words Lisa Farrington, 2025 The first book to center Black artists voices on Black aesthetics revealing a century of evolving relationships to race identity and art What is Black art No one has thought harder about that question than Black artists yet their perspectives have been largely ignored Instead their stories have been told by intellectuals like W E B Du Bois and Alain Locke who defined a school of Black art in the early twentieth century For the first time *Black Artists in Their Own Words* offers an insightful corrective Esteemed art historian Lisa Farrington gathers writing spanning a century across the United States the Caribbean and the African continent including from renowned artists Henry Tanner Nancy Elizabeth Prophet Romare Bearden Wifredo Lam Renee Cox and many more that reveals both evolutions and equivocations Many artists especially during the civil rights era have embraced Black aesthetics as a source of empowerment Others prefer to be artists first and Black second while some have rejected racial identification entirely Here Black artists reclaim their work from reductive critical narratives sharing the motivations underlying their struggles to create in a white dominated art world

The First Passage Colin A. Palmer, 1994 The history of African Americans begins in Africa a continent that was home to people with different languages traditions histories and religions They called themselves Twi Yoruba Zulu Ashanti and Kumba among other names In the early sixteenth century Europeans turned to Africa for the labor force needed to mine cultivate and process the bounty of natural resources in the newly colonized Americas As many as 12 million Africans from varied ethnic backgrounds endured forced migration and enslavement Out of their suffering was forged a new people no longer simply Twi Yoruba Ashanti or Kumba In the Americas they first became Africans and then African Americans *The First Passage* examines the first century of the recorded black presence in the Americas The ordeal of the Atlantic crossing gave way to the isolation and humiliation of slavery and the loss of friends and family Some slaves attempted rebellion and escape Others maintained as many religious and cultural traditions as possible and as the African American population grew forged new traditions and new ties of kinship This history remains at the core of black life in the Americas Colin Palmer tells a story of extraordinary suffering But *The First Passage* is also a timeless lesson in endurance and survival

Let My People Go Deborah Gray White, 1996-09-12 In 1800 black voices began to rise against slavery People like Gabriel Prosser and Nat Turner attempted to launch slave rebellions against the system Others such as Maria Stewart and Frederick Douglass wrote books pamphlets and speeches calling for the abolition of slavery in the land of the free The voices of abolitionists both black and white helped end slavery in the Northern states during the early 19th century But Southern plantation owners were unwilling to yield easily The industrial revolution made the market for cotton better than ever Inventor Eli Whitney's cotton gin could easily remove the seeds from cotton bolls a slow and tedious chore slaves had to do by hand and plantation owners were able to grow even more cotton with fewer hands They were not about to give up their slaves without a fight So African Americans struggled to be free and remain free as slaveholders fought to keep the

system alive and profitable Let My People Go explores what slavery was like for men women and children in white homes and plantations but it also shows how slaves created communities under bondage how they fought back and how they contributed to the system s decline Even in rare free communities the central goal of free African Americans beyond their very survival as a people was to fight for the complete abolition of slavery This sense of brotherhood of community speeded slavery s demise and still guides African American history today Let My People Go is a testament to the commitment and courage of those early communities

William Levi Dawson Mark Hugh Malone,2023-03-24 William Levi Dawson 1899 1990 overcame adversity and Jim Crow racism to become a nationally recognized composer choral arranger conductor and professor of music In William Levi Dawson American Music Educator Mark Hugh Malone tells the fascinating tale of Dawson s early life quest for education rise to success at the Tuskegee Institute achievement of national notoriety as a composer and retirement years spent conducting choirs throughout the US and world From his days as a

student at Tuskegee in the final years of Booker T Washington's presidency Dawson continually pursued education in music despite racial barriers to college admission Returning to Tuskegee later in life he became director of the School of Music Under his direction the Tuskegee Choir achieved national recognition by singing at Radio City Music Hall presenting concerts for Presidents Herbert Hoover and Franklin D Roosevelt and performing on nationwide radio and television broadcasts Dawson's Negro Folk Symphony only the second extended musical work to be written by an African American was premiered by Leopold Stokowski and the Philadelphia Orchestra in both Philadelphia and New York City Dawson's arrangements of spirituals the original folk music of African Americans enslaved in America during the antebellum period quickly became highly sought after choral works This biographical account of Dawson's life is narrated with a generous sprinkling of his personal memories and photographs

Kelley,1996-04-25 When something goes from bad to worse we say it fell out of the frying pan and into the fire This timeless phrases succinctly captures what has happened to the majority of African Americans since the 1970s The civil rights movement of the 1960s brought about remarkable gains for most black people and by 1970 African Americans were beginning to be key figures in national politics and in corporate board rooms The black middle class was decidedly growing and thus a handful of African Americans escaped the frying pan altogether But after 1970 heavy industry began to disappear as American companies looked to foreign lands for cheaper manufacturing Millions of jobs were lost The number of black

poor began to grow dramatically city services declined federal spending on cities dried up affirmative action programs were dismantled blatant acts of racism began to rise again and the United States entered a deep economic recession But this decline is only part of the story Since 1970 the black community has resisted oppression struggled for power dealt with internal tensions and conflicts and profoundly shaped American culture This book explores a range of issues that the African American community faces in the late 20th century the rebirth of black nationalism the emergence of a new black conservative movement the challenge of black feminism the impact of Caribbean immigration the rise of rap music and hip hop culture It looks at the impact on African American life of such diverse personalities as Roy Innis Toni Morrison Anita Hill Jimi Hendrix Louis Farrakhan Angela Davis Spike Lee Barbara Jordan Shirley Chisholm and Jesse Jackson among others Into the Fire will challenge and be challenged by readers of all ages and calls on our young people to exercise their power to determine the outcome of chapters yet to be written in the history of African Americans

Though Justice Sleeps Barbara Bair, 1997-04-03 The period of Reconstruction that followed the end of the Civil War was a time of both tremendous promise and the deep conflict of ideas At stake was the question of what the racial future of America would be In the years between 1880 and 1900 the wonderful promise of a future of freedom that was made to black people by emancipation was broken It was a promise that African Americans could conduct their daily lives with the assurance that their rights would be protected the assurance of wide awake and diligent social justice Instead justice slept African Americans did however make their own brand of liberty through their activism and their faith When John Solomon Lewis's family claimed their own land in Kansas or Bishop Henry McNeal Turner encouraged African Americans to take pride in Africa the flame of freedom was maintained When Richard L Davis organized mineworkers or black women in New Orleans marched in the streets in support of striking dockworkers they kindled the light of freedom that illuminated their path When Booker T Washington arrived in Tuskegee Alabama and started a school in Johanna Bowen Rudgrey's church that light was further kindled The message that African American activists of the 1880s and 1890s left for those in the 20th century was a clear one Frances Harper said it at the Chicago Women's Congress in 1893 Demand justice simple justice as the right of every race In **Though Justice Sleeps** Barbara Bair demonstrates that black people were more than victims of Jim Crow laws and racial violence She shows that they organized fought back moved around thought wrote and created works of art They connected their struggles with the rest of the world turning to Africa Europe and the Caribbean for guidance and inspiration
