Historically, body image concerns were thought to only affect white upper to middle class women in North America and Western Europe. However, empirical data accumulated in recent decades have subverted this myth. Contrary to popular belief and stereotypes that Asian Americans are a Model Minority in the United States, they experience significant body image concerns as well as related disordered eating and mental health challenges. Asian diasporas in Western countries also face challenges similar to those faced by Asian Americans, e.g., racialized and objectified views of Asians. Asian nationals in Asia, on the other hand, are juggling between their collective and national standards of beauty, fitness, and the body image ideals propagated through commercialism and capitalization amidst the historical context of colonization and the contemporary atmosphere of globalization.

Body Image and the Asian Experience: Asians, Asian Americans, and Asian Diasporas Across the Globe discusses the dearth of knowledge and sometimes misinformation about body image among people of Asian descent, including Asian nationals dwelling in Asia and those in the diaspora (Asian Americans, Asian immigrants in the United Kingdom, Australia, etc.). The first section of the book reviews the applicability of existing theories in understanding the body image experiences of individuals of Asian descent and proposes a new theoretical framework that emphasizes both decolonizing and intersectional perspectives in conceptualizing Asian body image. The next section examines the current state of research on body image among Asians, Asian Americans, and Asian diasporas around the globe, including attending to some seriously neglected specific demographic and social identity groups. The last section explores mental health and psychosocial implications of body image in the aspects of mental disorders, interpersonal and social relationships, and identity development. Chung, Kerry O'Connell, 2023-08-23 Face of the Enemy is not your run of the mill memoir The second son of a mixed race family of mainly Asian descent was challenge enough His father s American values were overpowered by his mother s enforcement of the traditional Chinese culture of her homeland His home life couldn t have been more dissimilar than the culture of 1960s Chicago that was just outside his front door Out on the streets his Asian face said I m not one of you At home his status as the Number Two son said I am a servant Chung Doc to his friends quickly learned that he had two identities and that he was trapped in between them He had to fight many times with his fists to discover where his place was in his own country The Vietnam War was winding down when Chung joined the Air Force As a transportation specialist for the United States Air Force in Vietnam he made sure aircraft delivering supplies were loaded and balanced properly How much trouble could there be Plenty as he discovered Many of his American comrades in arms viewed him with suspicion He

Lily Briscoe's Chinese Eyes Patricia Laurence, 2013-01-02 A map of the mutual influence of Bloomsbury the Crescent Moon Society and modernism in English and Chinese culture Lily Briscoe's *Chinese Eyes* traces the romance of Julian Bell nephew of Virginia Woolf and Ling Shuhua a writer and painter Bell met while teaching at Wuhan University in China in 1935 Relying on a wide selection of previously unpublished writings Patricia Laurence places Ling often referred to as the Chinese Katherine Mansfield squarely in the Bloomsbury constellation In doing so she counters East West polarities and suggests forms of understanding to inaugurate a new kind of cultural criticism and literary description Laurence expands her examination of Bell and Ling's relationship into a study of parallel literary communities Bloomsbury in England and the Crescent Moon group in China Underscoring their reciprocal influences in the early part of the twentieth century Laurence presents conversations among well known British and Chinese writers artists and historians including Virginia Woolf Vanessa Bell G L Dickinson Xu Zhimo E M Forster and Xiao Qian In addition Laurence's study includes rarely seen photographs of Julian Bell Ling and their associates as well as a reproduction of Ling's scroll commemorating moments in the exchange between Bloomsbury and the Crescent Moon group While many critics agree that modernism is a movement that crosses national boundaries literary studies rarely reflect such a view In this volume Laurence links unpublished letters and documents cultural artifacts art literature and people in ways that provide illumination from a comparative cultural and aesthetic perspective In so doing she addresses the geographical and critical imbalances and thus the architecture of modernist postcolonial Bloomsbury and Asian studies by placing China in an aesthetic matrix of a developing international modernism
