South Africa continues to be an object of fascination for people everywhere interested in social justice issues postcolonial studies and critical race theory as manifested by the enormous worldwide attention given to the RhodesMustFall movement In this book Teresa Barnes examines universities complex positioning in the apartheid era and argues that tracing the institutional legacies left by pro apartheid intellectuals are crucial to understanding the fight to transform South African higher education A work of interpretive social history this book investigates three historical dynamics in the relationship between the apartheid system and South African higher education First it explores how the legitimacy of apartheid was historically reproduced in public higher education Second it looks at ways that academics maneuvered through and influenced national and international discourses of political freedom and legitimacy Third it explores how and where stubborn tendrils of apartheid era knowledge production practices survived into and have been combatted during the democratic era in South African universities

Mandela's Kinsmen Timothy Gibbs, 2014 *Mandela's Kinsmen* is the first study of the fraught relationships between the ANC leadership and their relatives who ruled apartheid's foremost tribal Bantustan the Transkei In the early 20th century the chieftaincies had often been well springs of political leadership In the Transkei political leaders such as Mandela used regionally rooted clan schooling and professional connections to vault to leadership they crafted expansive nationalisms woven from these kin identities But from 1963 the apartheid government turned South Africa's chieftaincies into self governing tribal Bantustans in order to shatter African nationalism While historians often suggest that apartheid changed everything African elites being eclipsed by an era of mass township and trade union protest and the chieftaincies co-opted by the apartheid government there is another side to this story Drawing on newly discovered accounts and archives Gibbs reassesses the Bantustans and the changing politics of chieftaincy showing how local dissent within Transkei connected to wider political movements and ideologies Emphasizing the importance of elite politics he describes how the ANC in exile attempted to re-enter South Africa through the Bantustans drawing on kin networks This failed in KwaZulu but Transkei provided vital support after a coup in 1987 and the alliances forged were important during the apartheid endgame Finally in counterpoint to Africanist debates that focus on how South African insurgencies narrowed nationalist thought and practice he maintains ANC leaders calmed South Africa's conflicts of the early 1990s by espousing an inclusive nationalism that incorporated local identities and that Mandela's kinsmen still play a key role in state politics today Timothy Gibbs is a Lecturer in African History University College London Southern Africa South Africa Namibia Lesotho Swaziland Botswana Jacana

In debates about immigration, however, freedom is rarely mentioned. When it is raised, it is usually indirectly and the contending parties typically divide into those who question the wisdom or the morality of limiting the movement of would-be immigrants and others who think such restrictions warranted. The language of freedom rarely makes an appearance, perhaps because the liberty of foreigners or aliens does not really interest most people. Advocates of immigrants express a concern for the welfare of outsiders; others appeal to the welfare of natives and the integrity of the nation. The point of this book is to establish freedom as the basis of the immigration question. Chandran Kukathas argues that what's at stake is nothing less than the liberty of citizens and residents of the free society and therefore the free society itself. To put it simply, immigration controls are controls on people and it is not possible to control some people without controlling others. More specifically, it is not possible to control outsiders (aliens, foreigners, would-be immigrants) without controlling insiders as well and to enforce immigration control is to enforce control generally. The author shows why this must be so and explains why it is significant. Over the course of eight chapters and an epilogue, the book draws anecdotally on current and historical immigration practices in Canada, the United States, Australia, Japan, Singapore and most of the major Western European countries, but the information is deployed in service of an accessible first-principles argument. To assess immigration, he says, we must think then about what we value most about our society and also come to a clearer understanding about what we mean by immigration in the first place. In the conclusion, he defends the need for greater freedom of movement which ultimately means a world of more open borders.
