interests taken from the present or at the least from the recent past but many historians especially those who love research for its own sake will try to look at the past from a perspective either from that period or from even earlier Both camps look for roots but view them with different lenses and presuppositions This prolegomena has been added to prepare some philosophers for what will hopefully only be the mildest of shocks for seeing the history of philosophy in a way which does not treat what is recent or latest as best but which loves the context of ideas for its own sake a context which can be very foreign to contemporary likes and dislikes To be sure we historians can deceive ourselves as easily as philosophers but we tend to do so about different things
