Alliteration and Sound Change in Early English Donka Minkova, 2003-03-13 This 2003 study uses evidence from early English verse to reconstruct the course of some central phonological changes in the history of the language. It builds on the premise that alliteration reflects faithfully the acoustic identity and similarity of stressed syllable onsets. Individual chapters cover the history of the velars, the structure and history of vowel initial syllable onsets, the behaviour of onset clusters, and the chronology and motivation of cluster reduction: gn kn hr hl hn hw wr wl. Examination of the patterns of group alliteration in Old and Middle English reveals a hierarchy of cluster internal cohesiveness which leads to new conclusions regarding the causes for the special treatment of sp st sk in alliteration. The analysis draws on phonetically based Optimality Theoretic models. Control as Movement Cedric Boeckx, Norbert Hornstein, Jairo Nunes, 2010-08-26 The Movement Theory of Control MTC makes one major claim that control relations in sentences like John wants to leave are grammatically mediated by movement This goes against the traditional view that such sentences involve not movement but binding and analogizes control to raising albeit with one important distinction whereas the target of movement in control structures is a theta position in raising it is a non theta position however the grammatical procedures underlying the two constructions are the same This book presents the main arguments for MTC and shows it to have many theoretical advantages the biggest being that it reduces the kinds of grammatical operations that the grammar allows an important advantage in a minimalist setting It also addresses the main arguments against MTC using examples from control shift adjunct control and the control structure of promise showing MTC to be conceptually theoretically and empirically superior to other approaches

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
