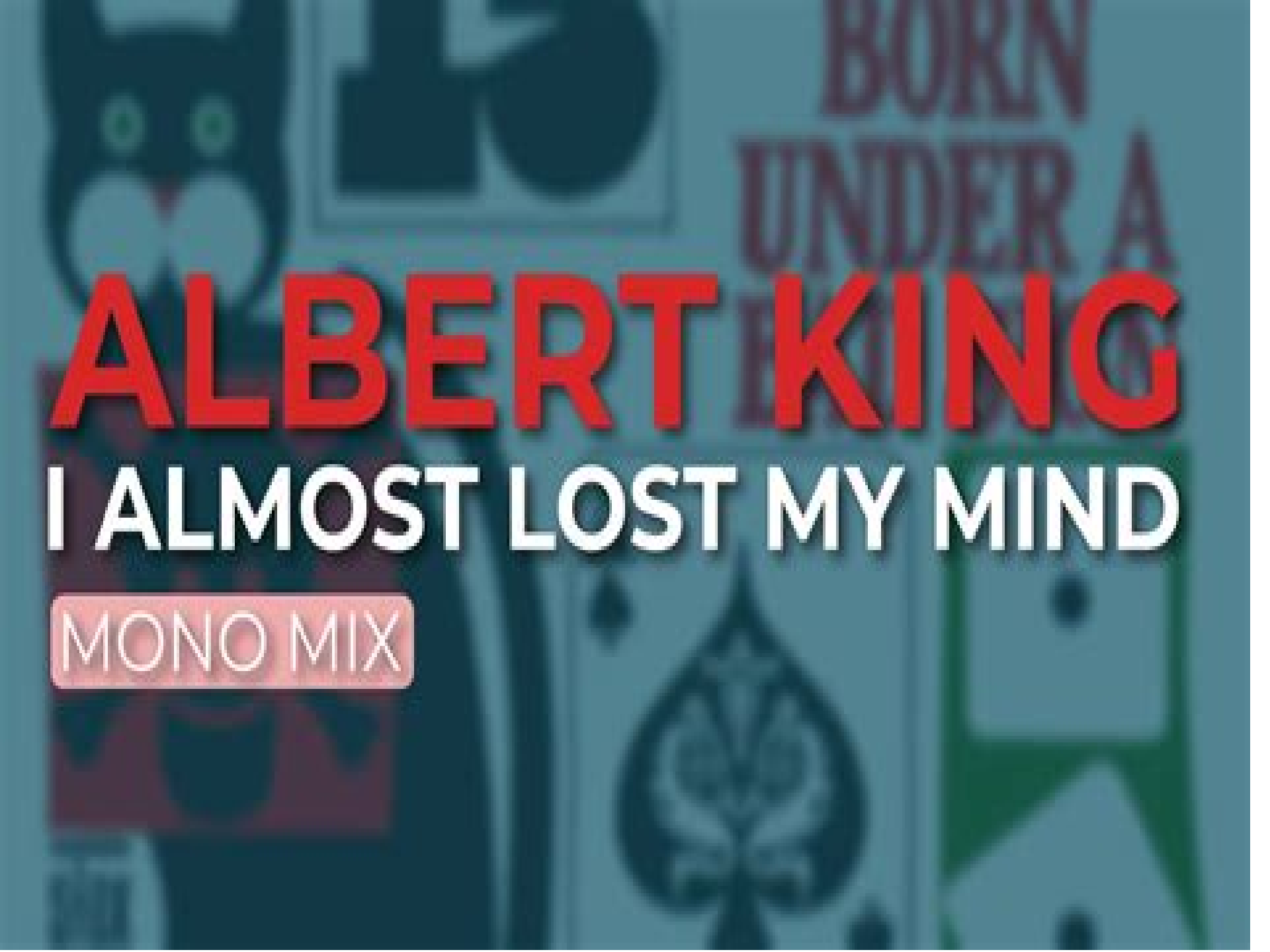

Almost Lost Ian McLaren, 2013 *A Selection* John Bunyan, 2008-08-15 *Stories of Vigilant Courage* Adam Hildebrand, 2008-08 If you find yourself at the bedside of a child with multiple handicaps and complex medical needs you need to read this book Whether you are a nurse doctor parent or family member health care professional or a personal ally of an individual who is disabled you will benefit from reading the stories in the book and the analysis of issues by the editor It sometimes happens that some people whether a professional or not will be tempted to think of such children as better off dead an extremely dangerous assumption Illness and suffering do not diminish the value of a person s life and no one has the right to decide whether or not a person should live or die This book gives firsthand accounts of the experiences of handicapped children and their families in health care settings Their experiences vary from doctor to doctor nurse to nurse and hospital to hospital The key difference is that some people held a strong belief that every person s life has intrinsic value and that their lives were sacred Yet others measured the value of a life according to external factors such as level of disability impairments and level of suffering whether presumed or real You can guess which people gave better care and which children lived longer and better accordingly In spite of the difficult challenges that handicapped children and their families face as described in these stories this book is a book of hope You will be inspired by the courageous tenacity of parents who literally stood at the bedside of their children often for months and protected and affirmed the well being of their child This is a book about people who made a difference a difference between life and death *Sancho's Journal* David Montejano, Maceo Montoya, 2012-11-15 How do people acquire political consciousness and how does that consciousness transform their behavior This question launched the scholarly career of David Montejano whose masterful explorations of the Mexican American experience produced the award winning books *Anglos and Mexicans in the Making of Texas* 1836 1986 a sweeping outline of the changing relations between the two peoples and *Quixote s Soldiers A Local History of the Chicano Movement* 1966 1981 a concentrated look at how a social movement from below began to sweep away the last vestiges of the segregated social political order in San Antonio and South Texas Now in *Sancho s Journal* Montejano revisits the experience that set him on his scholarly quest hanging out as a participant observer with the South Side Berets of San Antonio as the chapter formed in 1974 *Sancho s Journal* presents a rich ethnography of daily life among the batos locos crazy guys as they joined the Brown Berets and became associated with the greater Chicano movement Montejano describes the motivations that brought young men into the group and shows how they learned to link their individual troubles with the larger issues of social inequality and discrimination that the movement sought to redress He also recounts his own journey as a scholar who came to realize that before he could tell this street level story he had to understand the larger history of Mexican Americans and their struggle for a place in U S society *Sancho s Journal* completes that epic story **The Complete Novels of Henry James** Henry James, 2023-12-14 *The Complete Novels of Henry James* serves as a comprehensive collection capturing the

Originally published in 1880 as a serial in *Cornhill Magazine* and *Harper's New Monthly Magazine*, it is a structurally simple tragicomedy that recounts the conflict between a dull but sweet daughter and her brilliant, unemotional father. The plot of the novel is based upon a true story told to James by his close friend, British actress Fanny Kemble. Irving completed *A History of New York from the Beginning of the World to the End of the Dutch Dynasty* by Diedrich Knickerbocker. It was his first major book and a satire on self-important local history and contemporary politics. Before its publication, Irving started a hoax by placing a series of missing person advertisements in New York newspapers seeking information on Diedrich Knickerbocker, a crusty Dutch historian who had allegedly gone missing from his hotel in New York City.
