popular basis The contribution of Federal Union to the development of the federal idea in Great Britain and Europe was to express and organise the beginning of a new political militancy and it represented the first step of a historical process the overcoming of the nation State the modern political formula which institutionalises the political division of mankind This study principally examines the first eighteen months of the Federal Union during which time it was able to raise itself to the attention of the general public and the political class as the heir of the League of Nations Union The research is based on extensive unpublished archival material found across the globe from London Oxford Brighton and Edinburgh to Washington Paris and Geneva
