Chain of Change Mel King, 1981 *Chain of Change* is a history of the black community in Boston from the fifties through the seventies Mel King shows how black consciousness and power have developed through the struggles around jobs housing education and politics For the future he proposes a strategy of community controlled economic development and political representation which is relevant to any major city

Black Movement Jeffrey O. G. Activists in City Hall Pierre Clavel, 2013-02-15 In 1983 Boston and Chicago elected progressive mayors with deep roots among community activists Taking office as the Reagan administration was withdrawing federal aid from local governments Boston's Raymond Flynn and Chicago's Harold Washington implemented major policies that would outlast them More than reforming governments they changed the substance of what the government was trying to do above all to effect a measure of redistribution of resources to the cities poor and working classes and away from hollow goals of growth as measured by the accumulation of skyscrapers In Boston Flynn moderated an office development boom while securing millions of dollars for affordable housing In Chicago Washington implemented concrete measures to save manufacturing jobs against the tide of national policy and trends *Activists in City Hall* examines how both mayors achieved their objectives by incorporating neighborhood activists as a new organizational force in devising debating implementing and shaping policy Based in extensive archival research enriched by details and insights gleaned from hours of interviews with key figures in each

Denver Houston Los Angeles San Francisco and Seattle Each chapter traces the economic social and political changes since 1965 and current political problems It is impossible to do justice to all thirteen studies in a short review but this book represents a very useful summation of the current state of the major US cities Environment and Planning C In 1965 Big City Politics ambitiously attempted to describe the workings of America s big cities using nine large U S cities as examples By the time it was published urban racial conflict declining economic power and growing concentrations of low income populations had changed the face of the urban political scene Big City Politics in Transition examines how government and administration in America s largest cities have changed between 1960 and 1990 The contributors to this intriguing volume trace demographic and economic change over this vital and at times turbulent period explaining what those changes mean for politics policies and the general quality of life The chapters address the demographics and economic base of the cities under consideration the role and structure of city government including interaction with state houses suburbs and Washington DC and the roles played by interest groups and political influentials The cities profiled include Boston Philadelphia Chicago Detroit St Louis Atlanta Miami New Orleans Denver Houston Los Angeles San Francisco and Seattle Underlying these concerns is an examination of the political character of the city the composition and cohesion of the coalitions groups organizations and individual actors that shape major decisions A balanced and insightful look at urban politics in the late 20th century this volume will enlighten academics and professionals in urban studies policy studies and political science

teenager if there was a typical teenager In this richly illustrated account of Youth in postwar Buffalo William Graebner argues that the so called Youth culture was really a variety of disparate subcultures united by age but in conflict over class race ethnicity and gender Using scrap books oral histories school Yearbooks and material culture he shows how Buffalo teenagers were products of diverse and often antagonistic subcultures The innocuous strains of Rock Around the Clock muffled the seething gang loyalties and countercultural influence of James Dean Marlon Brando and Buffalo's own Hound Dog Lorenz Racial antipathies once held in check spilled out on Memorial Day 1956 when white and black Youth clashed on board a take Erie pleasure boat in a riot that recast the city's race relations for decades to come While exploring the diversity within Youth subcultures Graebner examines the ways in which adults educators clergy representatives of the media and other authorities sought to contain this generation The Hi Teen Club Buffalo Plan dress code record hops graduation ceremonies film censorship and restrictions on secret societies and on corner lounging were all forms of social engineering that reinforced social and economic boundaries that were at the heart of the dominant culture The prevailing adult influence on activities attitudes and style served to redirect the misguided Youth of the fifties and to obliterate their image from public memory Although the media still portrays this decade as the golden age of cultural homogeneity the diversity in musical preferences hair and clothing styles and allegiances to disc jockeys suggest the wide diversity of Youth experiences and challenges to adult authority that were part of coming of age in postwar America

Little Saigons Karin Aguilar-San Juan, 2009 Karin Aguilar San Juan examines the contradictions of Vietnamese American community and identity in two emblematic yet different locales Little Saigon in suburban Orange County California widely described as the capital of Vietnamese America and the urban Vietnamese town of Fields Corner in Boston Massachusetts Their distinctive qualities challenge assumptions about identity and space growth amid globalization and processes of Americanization With a comparative and race cognizant approach Aguilar San Juan shows how places like Little Saigon and Fields Corner are sites for the simultaneous preservation and redefinition of Vietnamese identity Intervening in debates about race ethnicity multiculturalism and suburbanization as a form of assimilation this work elaborates on the significance of place as an integral element of community building and its role in defining Vietnamese American-ness Staying Vietnamese according to Aguilar San Juan is not about replicating life in Viet Nam Rather it involves moving toward a state of equilibrium that though always in flux allows refugees immigrants and their U S born offspring to recalibrate their sense of self in order to become Vietnamese anew in places far from their presumed geographic home

The Puerto Rican Movement Andrés Torres, José Emiliano Velázquez, 1998 Little attention has been paid to the Latino movements of the 1960s and 1970s in the literature of social movements This volume is the first significant look at the organizations that emerged in the late 1960s to promote Puerto Rican independence and the radical transformation of U S society The Puerto Rican movement was a response to U S colonialism on the island and to the poverty and discrimination faced by most Puerto Ricans on the mainland This anthology

looks at the organizations that emerged to combat these two problems in such places as Boston Chicago Hartford New York and Philadelphia Almost all the contributors worked with the organizations they describe Interviews with such key figures as Elizam Escobar Piri Thomas and Luis Fuentes as well as accounts by people active in the gay lesbian African American and white Left movements create a vivid picture of why and how people became radicalized and how their ideals intersected with their group's own dynamics
