

provide the student with a well-documented foundation for his researches. Some of Mr. Baker's material appears familiar at first sight until it is realized that his study of the furniture of Tutankhamun is the first comprehensive survey ever published, and the remarkable household equipment of the architect Kha, now in Turin, is similarly not well known in England. The latter forms part of a collection of non-royal material which also gives some insight into the lives of simpler folk.

The Egyptian material then is of major importance, but that from the Near East is almost more interesting because it has been much less studied. Here representations of furniture have to provide most of the evidence in place of the actual objects preserved in Egypt, but the variety of seats depicted on the cylinder seals, for example, dating from prehistoric Mesopotamia to the Late Assyrian period, could provide a remarkable history of household goods in miniature. Recent discoveries such as the splendid ivories from Nimrud bear witness to the elaborate decoration of some of this furniture, and fragments of ivory, bronze, and wood from Jericho, Megiddo, and Gordion illustrate the chapters on Ancient Palestine and Asia Minor. With the Aegean we soon reach more familiar ground. The appendix on techniques together with the series of measured drawings by Miss M. S. Macdonald-Taylor remind us that Mr. Baker approaches his subject from a practical as well as from an artistic standpoint. As a result his work is of interest to both archaeologists, art-historians, and modern designers.

In this superbly illustrated book Sir Mortimer Wheeler develops the story of civilization in the Indian sub-continent, from the village societies in the Baluch-Indus borderland of the middle of the third millennium to the full flowering and southerly expansion of the Mauryan Empire at the beginning of the third century B.C. The text is more than a commentary on the handsome plates and represents a clear statement and synthesis of current developments in the sub-continent up to 1965. The account of the Indus Civilization deservedly claims the greater part of the book and serves to emphasize that even though our knowledge of the economy, trading connexions, and urban life of its people is extensive, their material origins still remain in doubt despite the location and excavation of pre-Harappan levels in Sind and Rajasthan. Similarly, the pictographic symbols on the seals remain undeciphered and whereas recent C14 dates suggest that the civilization flourished between 2300 and 1700 B.C., submerged levels at Mohenjo-daro imply that this site at least was settled much earlier. Due emphasis is given to the convincing geological explanation for the decline of the Indus Civilization—an uplift of the coast-line which isolated Harappan ports from the Makran coast and which resulted in the periodic flooding of the urban settlements in the upper reaches of the rivers. These factors would have been sufficient to ensure a progressive decline (which is reflected in certain Harappan town plans), without recourse to the Aryan invasion. The cultural sequence is traced beyond this decline, through the Gangetic Civilization and the acquisition of iron to the Persian colonization and the growth of the Mauryan Empire, with its subsequent expansion to south India and trading connexions with Rome.
