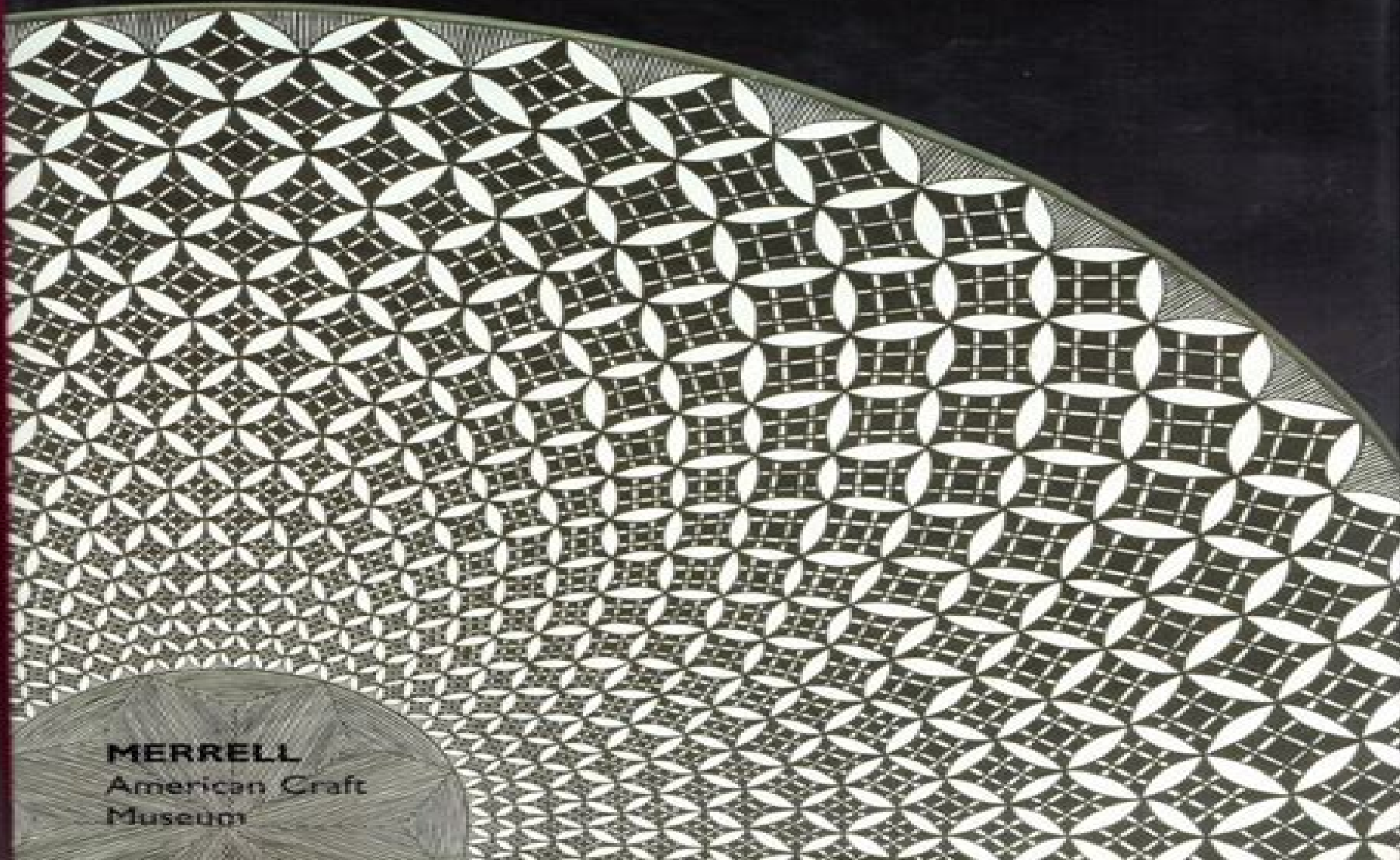


Changing Hands: Art Without Reservation, 1

Robbins, 2011-10-01 Both a tribute to the unique experiences of individual Native Americans and a celebration of the values that draw American Indians together this book explores contemporary Native life Based on personal experience and grounded in journalism this story begins with the repatriation of ancestral remains excavated during an archaeological expedition nearly a century earlier to the Pueblo peoples of New Mexico This event along with subsequent repatriations has accelerated similar momentum across much of Native America Author Catherine C Robbins traces this restorative effect in areas such as economic development urbanization the arts science and health care Through dozens of interviews Robbins draws out the voices of Indian people some well known and many at the grassroots level to speak against the background of the narrative's historical context The result is a rich account of Native American life in contemporary America revealing not a monolithic Indian experience but rather a mosaic of diverse peoples existing on a continuum that marks both their distinctions and their shared realities From publisher description **Crafting America** Glenn Adamson, Jen Padgett, 2021-01-29 A companion to the exhibition Crafting America curated at Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art this publication explores the interdisciplinary contexts of the assembled works featuring contributions from scholars with expertise in art history American studies folklore and museum studies Essay topics include the significance of craft within Native American histories and explorations of craft's relationship to ritual and memory personal independence and abstraction The Indian Craze Elizabeth Hutchinson, 2009-03-23 An historical examination of the early twentieth century Indian Craze a widespread interest in Native American art that explores its importance for Native Americans Euro Americans and the history of modernism *Navajo Weaving in the Late Twentieth Century* Ann Lane Hedlund, 2004-10 According to the Navajos the holy people Spider Man and Spider Woman first brought the tools for weaving to the People Over the centuries Navajo artists have used those tools to weave a web of beauty a rich tradition that continues to the present day In testimony to this living art form this book presents 74 dazzling color plates of Navajo rugs and wall hangings woven between 1971 and 1996 Drawn from a private southwestern collection they represent the work of sixty of the finest native weavers in the American Southwest The creations depicted here reflect a number of styles revival sandpainting pictorial miniature sampler and a number of major regional variations from Ganado to Teec Nos Pos Textile authority Ann Hedlund provides an introductory narrative about the development of Navajo textile collecting including the shift of attention from artifacts to art and a brief review of the history of Navajo weaving She then comments on the shaping of the particular collection represented in the book offering a rich source of knowledge and insight for other collectors Explaining themes in Navajo
