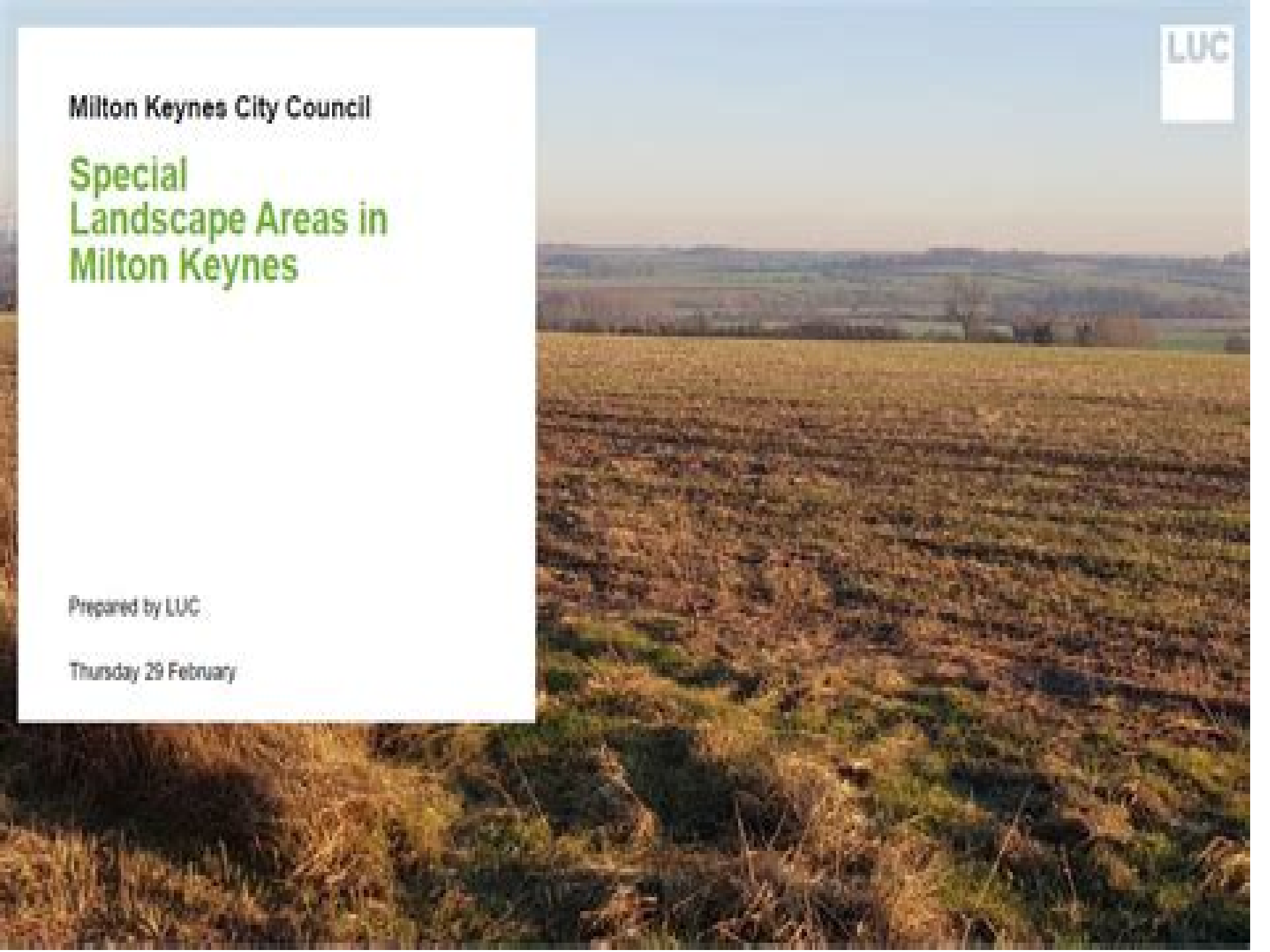

Mynard, 1993 The creation of the new town of Milton Keynes provided an opportunity to study an extensive rural landscape before it was changed irreversibly This book brings together the results of 20 years of excavation fieldwork and documentary studies carried out by the Milton Keynes Development Corporation in advance of the development of the new town It paints a picture of the changing landscape of the area from prehistoric times to the early 20th century

Building for a Changing Climate Peter F. Smith, 2009-12-01 There is now a practically universal consensus that our climate is changing rapidly and as a direct result of human activities While there is extensive debate about what we can do to mitigate the damage we are causing it is becoming increasingly clear that a large part of our resources will have to be directed towards adapting to new climatic conditions with talk of survivability replacing sustainability as the new and most pressing priority Nowhere is this more evident than in the built environment the stage on which our most important interactions with climatic conditions are played out In this frank yet pervasively positive book sustainable architecture guru Peter Smith lays out his vision of how things are likely to change and what those concerned with the planning design and construction of the places we live and work can and must do to avert the worst impacts Beginning with the background to the science and discussion of the widely feared graver risks not addressed by the politically driven IPCC reports he moves on to examine the challenges we will face and to propose practical responses based on real world experiences and case studies taking in flood and severe weather protection energy efficient retrofitting distributed power generation and the potential for affordable zero carbon homes He ends with a wider discussion of options for future energy provision This will be a provocative persuasive and crucially practical read for anyone concerned with the measures we must take now to ensure a climate proofed future for humanity

The Landscape Archaeology of Anglo-Saxon England N. J. Higham, Martin J. Ryan, 2010 The Anglo Saxon period was crucial to the development of the English landscape but is rarely studied The essays here provide radical new interpretations of its development Traditional opinion has perceived the Anglo Saxons as creating an entirely new landscape from scratch in the fifth and sixth centuries AD cutting down woodland and bringing with them the practice of open field agriculture and establishing villages Whilst recent scholarship has proved this simplistic picture wanting it has also raised many questions about the nature of landscape development at the time the changing nature of systems of land management and strategies for settlement The papers here seek to shed new light on these complex issues Taking a variety of different approaches and with topics ranging from the impact of coppicing to medieval field systems from the representation of the landscape in manuscripts to cereal production and the type of bread the population preferred they offer striking new approaches to the central issues of landscape change across the seven

Terkenli, Anne-Marie d'Hautesserre, 2006-07-13 Making sense of new cultural economies it is argued needs consistent attention to the resonances of individual lives Otherwise a discussion of cultural economies remains suspended in a detached virtualism Miller 2000 The idea of the remaking of geographies and cultural economies remains necessarily a consistent search to make the subject dynamic in its resonance with the contemporary world In recent debates concerning the reframing of the cultural economies of geography there is an evidence of increasing acknowledgement of the overlooked importance of subjectivities within geographical explanation This has often been difficult when trying to attend to the large scale apparent dynamics of change The shift of geographies to focus upon cultural economies combines two profound threads that inform this chapter the acknowledgement of the breadth and inclusivity of what economies are and the refusal mutually to isolate the cultural and the economic Thus the economic becomes engaged and even framed in relation to the cultural and vice versa Such an appraisal makes more robust the limits of either or claims from these two grounding components of geographical thinking and its representation of the world These themes are sustained in different ways across the chapters of this book This chapter seeks to build a critical discourse concerning space embodied practice and lay knowledge It does this in order to address the mechanisms through which individuals are engaged in the processes of new cultural economies

Handbook of Research Methods for Tourism and Hospitality Management Robin Nunkoo,2018-07-27 As research in tourism and hospitality reaches maturity a growing number of methodological approaches are being utilized and in addition this knowledge is dispersed across a wide range of journals Consequently there is a broad and multidisciplinary community of tourism and hospitality researchers whom at present need to look widely for support on methods In this volume researchers fulfil a pressing need by clearly presenting methodological issues within tourism and hospitality research alongside particular methods and share their experiences of what works what does not work and where challenges and innovations lie **Adapting to climate change** Great Britain: Parliament: House of Commons: Environmental Audit Committee,2010-03-25 Climate projections show that Britain can expect wetter winters drier summers and a higher likelihood of flash floods heat waves and droughts Yet adaptation to climate change has been given only a fraction of the attention that has gone into reducing greenhouse gases The Government must build awareness and support for the wide ranging and urgent programme of action that is needed to protect people property and prosperity and safeguard the natural environment Adapting infrastructure and homes will be expensive To maintain current levels of flood protection for homes real terms spending on flood defences will need to increase from its current level of around 600 million per annum to around 1 billion in 2035 Estimates in 2009 suggest that by the end of the century around 7 billion may be needed to improve the Thames flood barrier and tidal defences New homes being built now must be designed to cope with the inevitable changes in climate over the next 50 80 years The Government must make adaptation and mitigation more central to the planning system New developments should only be permitted if they are suited to future climates Existing homes will also need to be adapted so that they are comfortable during hotter summers and better protected against the risk of flooding The Government must help to kick start an integrated retro fitting programme that covers adaptation water efficiency and energy efficiency Green infrastructure such as water storage greater tree cover and more open green spaces must also be promoted

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
