Not My Mother's Sister Astrid Henry, 2004-09-07 No matter how wise a mother's advice is we listen to our peers At least that's writer Naomi Wolf's take on the differences between her generation of feminists the third wave and the feminists who came before her and developed in the late 60s and 70s the second wave In *Not My Mother's Sister* Astrid Henry agrees with Wolf that this has been the case with American feminism but says there are problems inherent in drawing generational lines Henry begins by examining texts written by women in the second wave and illustrates how that generation identified with yet also disassociated itself from its feminist foremothers Younger feminists now claim the movement as their own by distancing themselves from the past By focusing on feminism's debates about sexuality they are able to reject the so called victim feminism of Catherine MacKinnon and Andrea Dworkin Rejecting the orthodoxies of the second wave younger feminists celebrate a woman's right to pleasure Henry asserts however that by ignoring diverse older voices the new

generation has oversimplified generational conflict and has underestimated the contributions of earlier feminists to women's rights. They have focused on issues relating to personal identity at the expense of collective political action. Just as writers like Wolf, Katie Roiphe and Rene Denfeld celebrate a new feminist hetero sexuality posited in generational terms, queer and lesbian feminists of the third wave similarly distance themselves from those who came before. Henry shows how 1970s lesbian feminism is represented in ways that are remarkably similar to the puritanical portrait of feminism offered by straight third wavers. She concludes by examining the central role played by feminists of color in the development of third wave feminism. Indeed the term third wave itself was coined by Rebecca Walker, daughter of Alice Walker. *Not My Mother's Sister* is an important contribution to the exchange of ideas among feminists of all ages and persuasions. **Engendering**

Curriculum History Petra Hendry, 2011-05-20 How can curriculum history be re-envisioned from a feminist poststructuralist perspective? *Engendering Curriculum History* disrupts dominant notions of history as linear, as inevitable progress and as embedded in the individual. This conversation requires a history that seeks remembrance, not representation; reflexivity, not linearity; and responsibility, not truth. Rejecting a compensatory approach to rewriting history, which leaves dominant historical categories and periodization intact, Hendry examines how the narrative structures of curriculum histories are implicated in the construction of gendered subjects. Five central chapters take up a particular discourse: wisdom, the body, colonization, progressivism and pragmatism, to excavate the subject identities made possible across time and space. Susan Gubar, 2000-03-07 Is feminism dead as has been claimed by notable members of the media and the academy Has feminist knowledge with its proliferation of methodologies and fields been purchased at the price of power Are the conflicts among feminists evidence of self destructive infighting or do they herald the emergence of innovative modes of inquiry Given a feminism now ensconced within higher education as specialized or fractious scholarship Susan Gubar's Critical Condition Feminism at the Turn of the Century demonstrates that an invigorated concentration on activism and artistry can accentuate not the clinical or disparaging meaning of critical but its sense of compelling urgency and irreverent vitality As a pioneer of feminist studies and the object of some of the more rancorous criticism lodged against early feminist scholars Gubar stands in a unique position to comment on current dilemmas Moving beyond defensiveness produced by generational rivalry the impasse propagated by smug deployments of identity politics and the obscurity of poststructuralist theory she claims that the very controversies that undermine feminism's unity also prove its resilience Gubar begins by considering the volatile impact of gender on recent redefinitions of race sexuality religion and class proposed by four important groups in contemporary feminism African American performance and visual artists lesbian creative writers Jewish American women and newly institutionalized female academics She then addresses major divisions including the rifts between various area studies and women's studies as well as strains between generations that both threaten and invigorate feminist inquiry Gubar's forays into art and activism politics and the profession provide a sometimes distressing sometimes comical sometimes optimistic view of feminism emerging from a time of contention into a lively period of pluralized perspectives and disciplines
