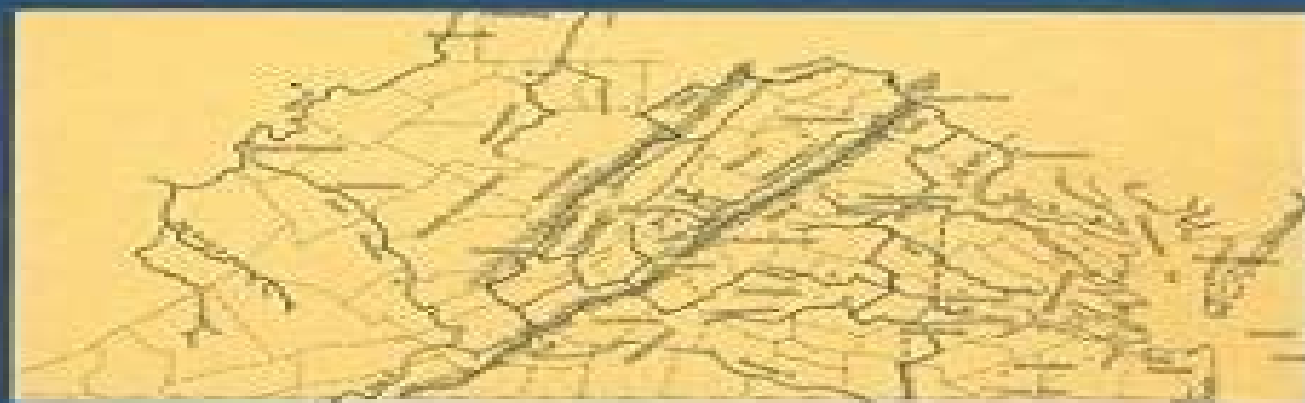

An African Republic Marie Tyler-McGraw,2009-11-30 The nineteenth century American Colonization Society ACS project of persuading all American free blacks to emigrate to the ACS colony of Liberia could never be accomplished Few free blacks volunteered and greater numbers would have overwhelmed the meager resources of the ACS Given that reality who supported African colonization and why No state was more involved with the project than Virginia where white Virginians provided much of the political and organizational leadership and black Virginians provided a majority of the emigrants In *An African Republic* Marie Tyler McGraw traces the parallel but seldom intersecting tracks of black and white Virginians interests in African colonization from revolutionary era efforts at emancipation legislation to African American churches concern for African missions In Virginia African colonization attracted aging revolutionaries republican mothers and their daughters bondpersons schooled and emancipated for Liberia evangelical planters and merchants urban free blacks opportunistic politicians Quakers and gentlemen novelists *An African Republic* follows the experiences of the emigrants from Virginia to Liberia where some became the leadership class consciously seeking to demonstrate black abilities while others found greater hardship and early death Tyler McGraw carefully examines the tensions between racial identities domestic visions and republican citizenship in Virginia and Liberia

Slavery in the American Republic David F. Ericson,2011-10-27 Many scholars believe that the existence of slavery stymied the development of the American state because slaveholding Southern politicians were so at odds with a federal government they feared would abolish their peculiar institution David Ericson argues to the contrary showing that over a seventy year period slavery actually contributed significantly to the development of the American state even as a house divided Drawing on deep archival research that tracks federal expenditures on slavery related items Ericson reveals how the policies practices and institutions of the early national government functioned to protect slavery and thereby contributed to its own development Here are surprising descriptions of how the federal government increased its state capacities as it implemented slavery friendly policies such as creating more stable slave markets by removing Native Americans deterring slave revolts recovering fugitive slaves enacting a ban on slave imports and not enacting a ban on the interstate slave trade It also bolstered its own law enforcement power by reinforcing navy squadrons to interdict illegal slave trading hiring deputy marshals to capture fugitive slaves and slave rescuers and deploying soldiers to remove Native Americans and deter slave rescues and revolts Going beyond Don Fehrenbacher s *The Slaveholding Republic* Ericson shows how the presence of slavery indirectly influenced the development of the American state in highly significant ways Enforcement of the 1808 slave import ban involved the federal government in border control for the first time and participation in founding a colony in Liberia established an early model of public private partnerships The presence of slavery also spurred the development of the U S Army through its many slavery related deployments particularly during the Second Seminole War and the federal government s own slave rentals influenced its labor

Egerton, 2000-11-09 Gabriel s Rebellion tells the dramatic story of what was perhaps the most extensive slave conspiracy in the history of the American South Douglas Egerton illuminates the complex motivations that underlay two related Virginia slave revolts the first in 1800 led by the slave known as Gabriel and the second called the Easter Plot instigated in 1802 by one of his followers Although Gabriel has

frequently been portrayed as a messianic Samson like figure Egerton shows that he was a literate and highly skilled blacksmith whose primary goal was to destroy the economic hegemony of the merchants the only whites he ever identified as his enemies According to Egerton the social political and economic disorder of the Revolutionary era weakened some of the harsh controls that held slavery in place during colonial times Emboldened by these conditions a small number of literate slaves most of them highly skilled artisans planned an armed insurrection aimed at destroying slavery in Virginia The intricate scheme failed as did the Easter Plot that stemmed from it and Gabriel and many of his followers were hanged By placing the revolts within the broader context of the volatile political currents of the day Egerton challenges the conventional understanding of race class and politics in the early days of the American republic **Journal of Early Southern**

Decorative Arts, 2002 **Artisan Workers in the Upper South** Diane Barnes, 2008-06-01 Though deeply entrenched in antebellum life the artisans who lived and worked in Petersburg Virginia in the 1800s including carpenters blacksmiths coach makers bakers and other skilled craftsmen helped transform their planter centered agricultural community into one of the most industrialized cities in the Upper South These mechanics as the artisans called themselves successfully lobbied for new railroad lines and other amenities they needed to open their factories and shops and turned a town whose livelihood once depended almost entirely on tobacco exports into a bustling modern city In *Artisan Workers in the Upper South* L Diane Barnes closely examines the relationships between Petersburg's skilled white free black and slave mechanics and the roles they played in southern Virginia's emerging market economy Barnes demonstrates that despite studies that emphasize the backwardness of southern development modern industry and the institution of slavery proved quite compatible in the Upper South Petersburg joined the industrialized world in part because of the town's proximity to northern cities and resources but it succeeded because its citizens capitalized on their uniquely southern resource slaves Petersburg artisans realized quickly that owning slaves could increase the profitability of their businesses and these artisans including some free African Americans entered the master class when they could Slave owning mechanics both white and black gained wealth and status in society and they soon joined an emerging middle class Not all mechanics could afford slaves however and those who could not struggled to survive in the new economy Forced to work as journeymen and face the unpleasant reality of permanent wage labor the poorer mechanics often resented their inability to prosper like their fellow artisans These differing levels of success Barnes shows created a sharp class divide that rivaled the racial divide in the artisan community Unlike their northern counterparts who united as a political force and organized strikes to effect change artisans in the Upper South did not rise up in protest against the prevailing social order Skilled white mechanics championed free manual labor a common refrain of northern artisans but they carefully limited the term free to whites and simultaneously sought alliances with slaveholding planters Even those artisans who didn't own slaves Barnes explains rarely criticized the wealthy planters who not only employed and traded with artisans but also controlled both state and local politics Planters too guarded against

disparaging free labor too loudly and their silence together with that of the mechanics helped maintain the precariously balanced social structure Artisan Workers in the Upper South rejects the notion of the antebellum South as a semifeudal planter centered political economy and provides abundant evidence that some areas of the South embraced industrial capitalism and economic modernity as readily as communities in the North
