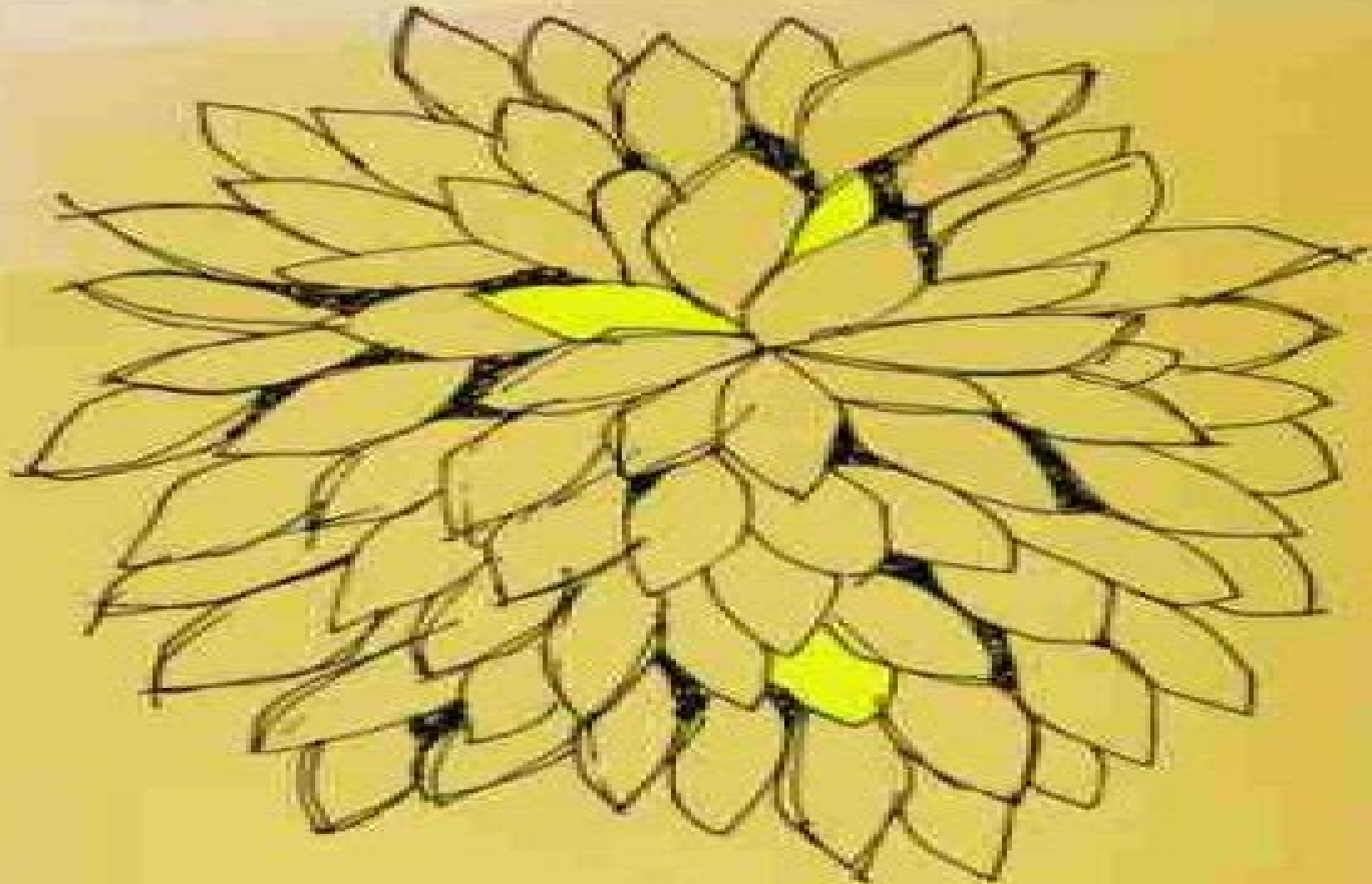


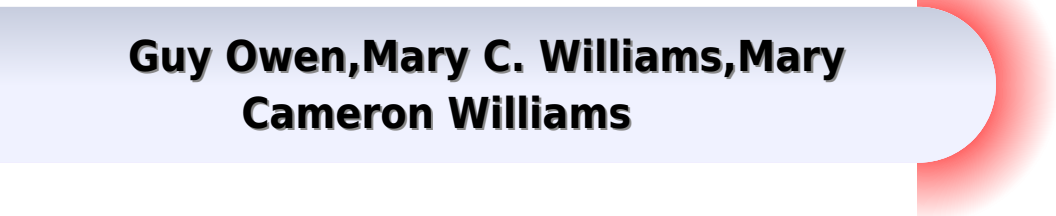

Chicorel Index to Poetry in Anthologies and Collections in Print Marietta Chicorel, 1974 **Driving to Biloxi** Edgar Simmons, 1968-06-01 **Boomerang ; Never Die** Barry Hannah, 1993 In *Boomerang* a novel told in vignettes both real and fictive a father attempting to cope with the tragic murder of his son learns that actions return to haunt or reward He becomes the embodiment of Hannah's ideal of forbearance dignity and decency in the face of incomprehensible death In *Never Die* Hannah mingles hilarity and horror as the frontier West is killed off by the onset of automobiles biplanes and nitroglycerine bombs A gallery of grotesque characters a judges evil dwarf henchman a nymphomaniacal schoolteacher and a homosexual doctor named Fingo populate this rollicking postmodern novel in which Old West myths collide with the anarchy of the twentieth century **The Life and Poetry of Frank Stanford** James McWilliams, 2025-07-01 The full throated biography fans have been yearning for Kirkus Starred Review April 2025 When twenty nine year old Frank Stanford put three bullets in his chest on June 3 1978 he ended a life that had been inextricably linked with poetry since childhood Deeply influential but largely unknown outside his corner of the poetry world this prodigy of the American South inspired a cult following that has kept his reputation and work flickering on the periphery of the American literary tradition ever since *The Life and Poetry of Frank Stanford* offers for the first time a comprehensive study of Stanford's life and work introducing to a broad readership poetry that remains both captivating to poets and in its celebration of everyday experience over academic erudition accessible to those who rarely read poetry Stanford's poems range from one line to his 15 283 line epic *The Battlefield Where the Moon Says I Love You* The vital thread running through all of his poetry is an ear for language that vies with Walt Whitman in its expansiveness and generosity Stanford's omnivorous attraction to vernacular particularly Black and rural vernacular centered on an admiration for the marginalized and eccentric Blending the Southern Gothic of Faulkner and O'Connor with a racially egalitarian vision his poetry thrives on the stories and traditions of the oppressed and forgotten The themes that preoccupied Stanford's prolific output language sex death class geography commercialism surrealism film race also preoccupied the poet in his daily life which was marked by heavy drinking philandering mental instability emotional abuse and through it all an inveterate desire for beauty Constantly attentive to this tension biographer James McWilliams traces the short and painfully complicated life of this hidden talent who left a lifetime's worth of poetry that through its grounding in the mundane achieved a vision of the transcendent *Touring Literary Mississippi* Patti Carr Black, Marion Garrard Barnwell, 2014-07-18 By taking the literary traveler on seven preplanned tours through the Delta along Highway 61 to the heart of Faulkner's Yoknapatawpha country to sites near Interstate 55 and the Natchez Trace to the piney woods of East and South Mississippi and along the sun struck Gulf Coast this book captures the phenomenal abundance and diversity of Mississippi literature More than a guidebook this book includes capsule biographies and well over a hundred photographs of writers their residences and their literary environments It also provides maps and gives explicit directions to writers
