They adapted existing concepts such as beauty, the sublime, natural theology, and fairylands, or coined new phrases such as many-sided comprehension to promote favored forms of embodiment and enculturate microscopy as a difficult but valuable pursuit. *Beautiful Mechanism* draws on important work in book history and periodical studies by emphasizing the circulation of these tropes in intermedial conversations across diverse print forms.
