Dual Diagnosis of Major Mental Illness and Substance Disorder: An Overview

The phenomenon of co-occurring major mental illness and substance disorder is now widely recognized. The Epidemiologic Catchment Area (ECA) study (Regier and others, 1984) confirmed the extensive comorbidity of substance disorders with a wide range of psychiatric disorders, including the most severe disorders, in the community. One-month odds ratios in three sites showed that people with schizophrenia, for example, have a 10.1 times greater rate of alcohol use disorders and a 7.6 times greater rate of other drug use disorders than nonschizophrenic people (Boyd and others, 1984). A more recent analysis of the ECA data (Regier and others, 1990) supported the increased risk of substance abuse or dependence among those with severe mental illnesses. For example, 47 percent of individuals with a lifetime diagnosis of schizophrenia or schizophreniform disorder had met criteria for some form of substance abuse or dependence.

The ECA study also confirmed Berkson's bias (Berkson, 1946)—that individuals with comorbidity are more likely to be found in clinical samples. The rates of diagnosed comorbidity in clinical settings continue to rise as clinicians become more aware of the high prevalence and more skilled at identifying multiple disorders (Lehmann, Myers, and Corty, 1989). Over a third of patients in general psychiatric settings and half or more of those in settings that provide more intensive treatment, such as psychiatric emergency rooms or inpatient psychiatric programs, have problems substantially affected by substance abuse or dependence (Galanter, Castaneda, and Ferman, 1988).
