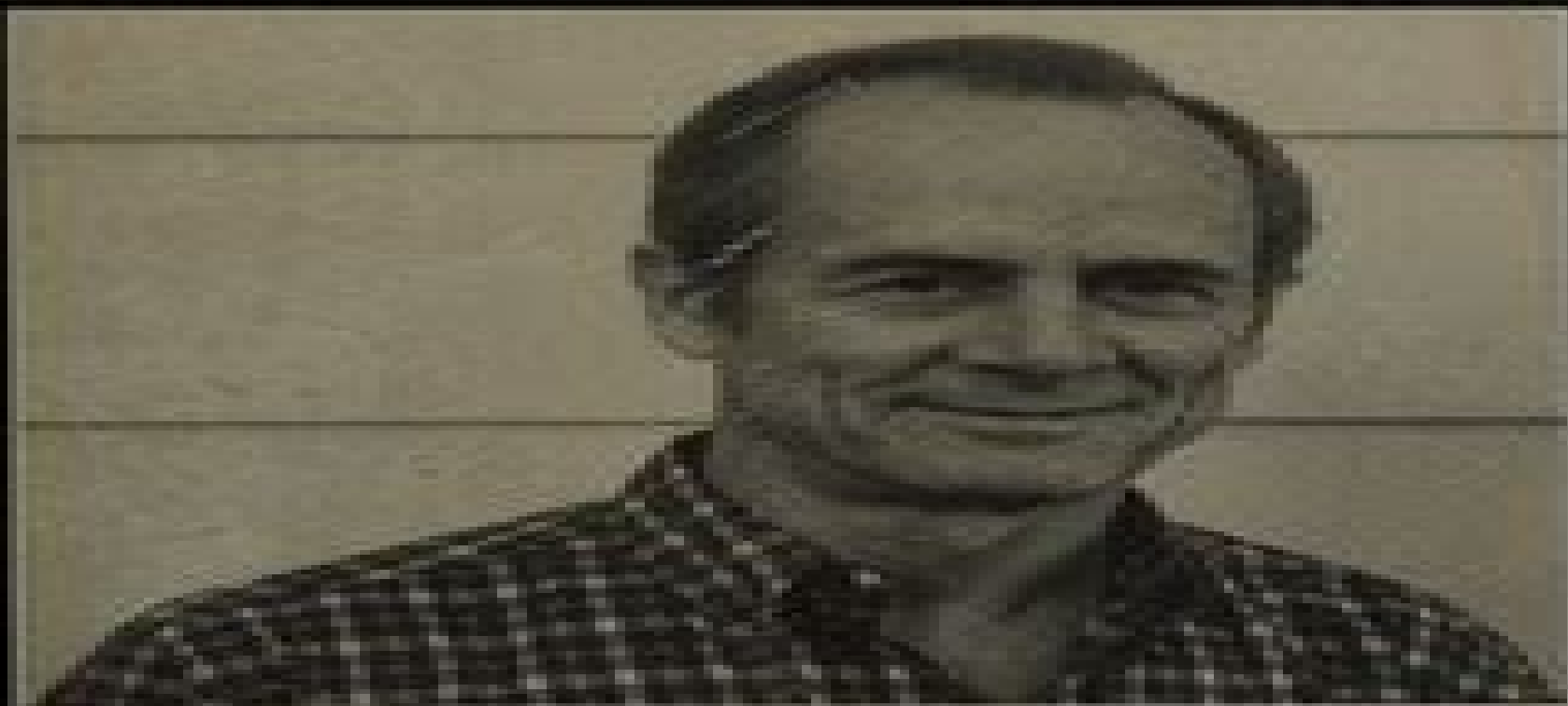




Popkin, 2013-03-14 In the early 1800s the late Charles B Schmitt and I discussed the fact that so much new research and new interpretations were taking place concerning various areas of modern skepticism that we as pioneers ought to organize a conference where these new findings and outlooks could be presented and discussed Charles and I had both visited the great library at Wolfenbiittel and were most happy when the Herzog August Bibliothek agreed to host the first conference on the history of skepticism in 1984 published as *Skepticism from the Renaissance to the Enlightenment* ed R H Popkin and Charles B Schmitt Wiesbaden 1987 *Wolfenbiitteler For schungen* vol 35 Charles and I projected a series of later conferences the first of which would deal with skepticism and irreligion in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries Unfortunately however Charles died suddenly in 1986 while lecturing in Padua Subsequent to his death Constance Blackwell his companion of many years established the Foundation for Intellectual History to support research and publica tion on topics in the history of ideas that continued Schmitt s interests One of the first ventures was to arrange and fund the already planned conference on skepticism and irreligion in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries After many difficulties and problems the conference was sponsored and funded by the Foundation for Intel lectual History one of its first public activities It was held at the lovely facilities of the Netherlands Institute for Advanced Studies in Wassenaar in 1990

There is an interesting and far reaching disagreement between Smith and Frederick Stoutland. In his *The Real Reasons*, Stoutland argues that one of the mistakes that turned the belief-desire model of action into the received view is the underlying commitment to the idea that there is an underlying unity to all action explanations. According to Stoutland, the unity is no deeper than the superficial fact that actions are responses of agents to the world, and the challenge for the philosophy of action is to make sense of that fact without falling victim to the unfruitful assumption that reasons should be understood as the normative content of determinate representational inner states of agents. Stoutland suggests an alternative according to which reasonable agents possess the know-how to respond appropriately to the normative import of the external situations they find themselves in. These situations are, Stoutland claims, the real reasons. Stoutland raises an important issue. If beliefs and desires should be understood as reasons, as introducing normative constraints that deserve respect, it seems we are bound to distinguish between, on the one hand, the content of our beliefs and desires, and on the other hand, their objects. Moreover, it seems we have good reasons to believe that the content of our beliefs and desires derives its normative import qua normative import from the objects of our beliefs and desires.

Hutto not only advances and explicates the claims of the NPH but he also challenges certain widely held assumptions. In this way Folk Psychological Narratives both clears conceptual space around the dominant approaches for an alternative and offers a groundbreaking proposal.

What is Misrepresentation? Krystyna Bielecka, 2025-05-23 This book aims to justify and systematize the desiderata that a satisfying philosophical account of mental representations should meet which is consistent with common sense practice and scientific research. According to the author the most important aspect of any satisfactory account of mental representation is the ability to determine that a given representation is incorrect and to identify the nature of the error.
