The first one, Chapter 4, is a translation of Milarepa's hitherto unstudied life story by one of his main disciples, Ngendzong Tonpa. Chapters 5, 6, and 7 are translations of specific topics as they appear in all the different texts: Milarepa's stay with his teacher Marpa, the encounter between Milarepa and Gampopa, and the teaching transmission of a specific meditation tradition from Milarepa to his disciple Rechungpa. Chapter 8 describes interesting details found in a text by Zhij Ripa. Chapter 9 compares the episode of a dying Bönpo in the different texts. In Chapter 10, three episodes from the biographical compendium *Life and Songs of the Glorious Laughing Vajra* are studied and compared with Tsangnyen Heruka's version. Chapter 11 gives an interesting interpretation of certain features of Mila's encounters with non-human beings due to the interconnections between inner winds and outer appearances. Chapter 12 analyses the colophons of the most ancient chapters in the texts regarding Mila's interactions with the Tseringma long-life sisters. Chapter 13 gives Mila's instructions on the intermediate states. Here, two different texts explaining the same instructions are compared to each other. Then follows a bibliography and an appendix containing 8 Song Charts in which the chapters and the songs in all these works are localised.
