variety of formal strategies for creating rhythmically unified scenes and sequences Music often served as a blueprint for rhythm and pacing as was the case in mickey mousing the close integration of music and movement in animation However by the mid 1930s filmmakers had also gained enough control over dialogue recording and editing to utilize dialogue to pace scenes independently of the music track Jacobs s highly original study of early sound film practices provides significant new contributions to the fields of film music and sound studies
