González Enciso, 2016-10-04 War Power and the Economy contains a comparative history of Great Britain France and Spain the three rival empires of the 1700s It explores how the states prepared for war what kind of economic means they had what institutional changes they implemented and how efficient this was As such the book presents the first comparative synthesis aiming to understand the outcome of the global confrontation in the eighteenth century Faced with the challenge of paying for new and more costly wars some countries found flexible ways to get more money and better supplies whereas others did not The development of freer colonial markets the increase of consumption and its taxation the problems of venal administration or the different systems of patronage with contractors are some of the factors explaining the divergences that were made clear by 1815 This book explores political and economic dimensions of the eighteenth century European state in order to explain why and how changes in power as an outcome of war depended upon the available means and the way they were obtained and used The book takes the idea that making war or preparing for it obliged governments to make important changes in their institutions so that during the eighteenth century the state in many ways formed itself through war efforts Ultimately this study aims to show how closely political and military success was entwined with economic interests This volume is of great interest to those who study economic history political economy and European history

history of the French Revolution Morris Slavin's study is the first that discusses the background the mechanisms and the immediate results of the uprising as well as the hidden forces that produced it and the contradictions that were inherent in it from the beginning Slavin's approach to the controversy between the Gironde and the Mountain is from below d'en bas from the vantage point of the sections of Paris and their extralegal assembly the Eveche assembly and its Comite des Neuf He shows how and why the Montagnards used the insurrectionary organs created by the sans culottes for their own purposes and how the Montagnards won them over against their Girondin enemies by granting the sans culottes economic concessions at the same time disarming them politically This revelation of the profound differences between the sans culottes and the Montagnards on the goals of the insurrection is a major contribution to understanding French revolutionary behavior Slavin finds that the rank and file in the pro Girondin sections were just as self sacrificing and just as patriotic as the followers of the Mountain The dispute between the Girondins and the Montagnards was an intraclass contest not a class struggle

French Emigration to Great Britain in Response to the French Revolution Juliette Reboul, 2017-08-25 This book examines diverse encounters between the British community and the thousands of French individuals who sought haven in the British Isles as they left revolutionary and Imperial France This painstaking research into the emigrant archival and memorial presence in Britain uncovers a wealth of underused and alternative sources on this controversial population displacement These include open letters and classified advertisements published in British newspapers insurance contracts as well as lists of addresses and passports drawn up by local authorities These sources question the construction by British loyalists and French migr elites of a stereotyped emigrant figure and their use of the trauma of forced displacement to advance ideological agendas In fact public and private discourses on governmental systems foreigners political and religious dissent and the economic survival of French emigrants demonstrate the heterogeneity of the responses to emigration in Britain Ultimately this book narrates a story in which the emigrant community and its host have been often unnoticeably yet fundamentally transformed by their encounter in both practical and ideological domains

Quatremère de Quincy David Gilks, 2024-05-31 Antoine Chrysosth me Quatrem re de Quincy 1755 1849 was the most distinguished writer on art and architecture at the end of the enlightenment However as David Gilks shows in Quatrem re de Quincy Art and Politics during the French Revolution he was never simply an esoteric antiquarian and theoretician he was also a zealous functionary and skilled publicist whose writings on the arts often served political purposes Quatrem re de Quincy Art and Politics during the French Revolution demonstrates how Quatrem re's early writings on art and antiquity formed the foundation for a politics grounded in faith authority and hierarchy that favoured gradual social and political evolution over destruction and experimentation Gilks then traces how Quatrem re set aside his antiquarian research and became a royalist politician and publicist during the revolutionary decade Quatrem re feared that the Revolution would destroy the cosmopolitan republic of letters that had flourished when states across Europe supported the papacy's rediscovery of the past restoration of taste and

revival of learning Yet Gilks reveals that Quatremere was also a resourceful and an opportunistic political actor who deployed his opponents language for strategic reasons Gilks therefore reinterprets Quatremere's interventions by situating them in their polemical contexts and treating them as contributions to debates and quarrels by locating his sources and reconstructing his social and political networks The resulting study revises our understanding of Quatremere's famous reflections on the Academy of Painting and Sculpture the Pantheon on art plunder and museums but it also discovers and sheds light on previously ignored writings Although the study focuses on the period 1789-1799 it examines the second half of Quatremere's life to substantiate his commitment to crown and altar and show how he fought against the Revolution's legacy of godless materialism and calculation that was inimical to the arts This is a thoroughly researched and richly detailed contextual study of the most eventful period in Quatremere's life but it also offers an original and unfamiliar history of the French Revolution Gilks integrates the study of political power with the history of ideas and art history and provides a window into institutional and legal reforms and debates about cultural patronage and education
