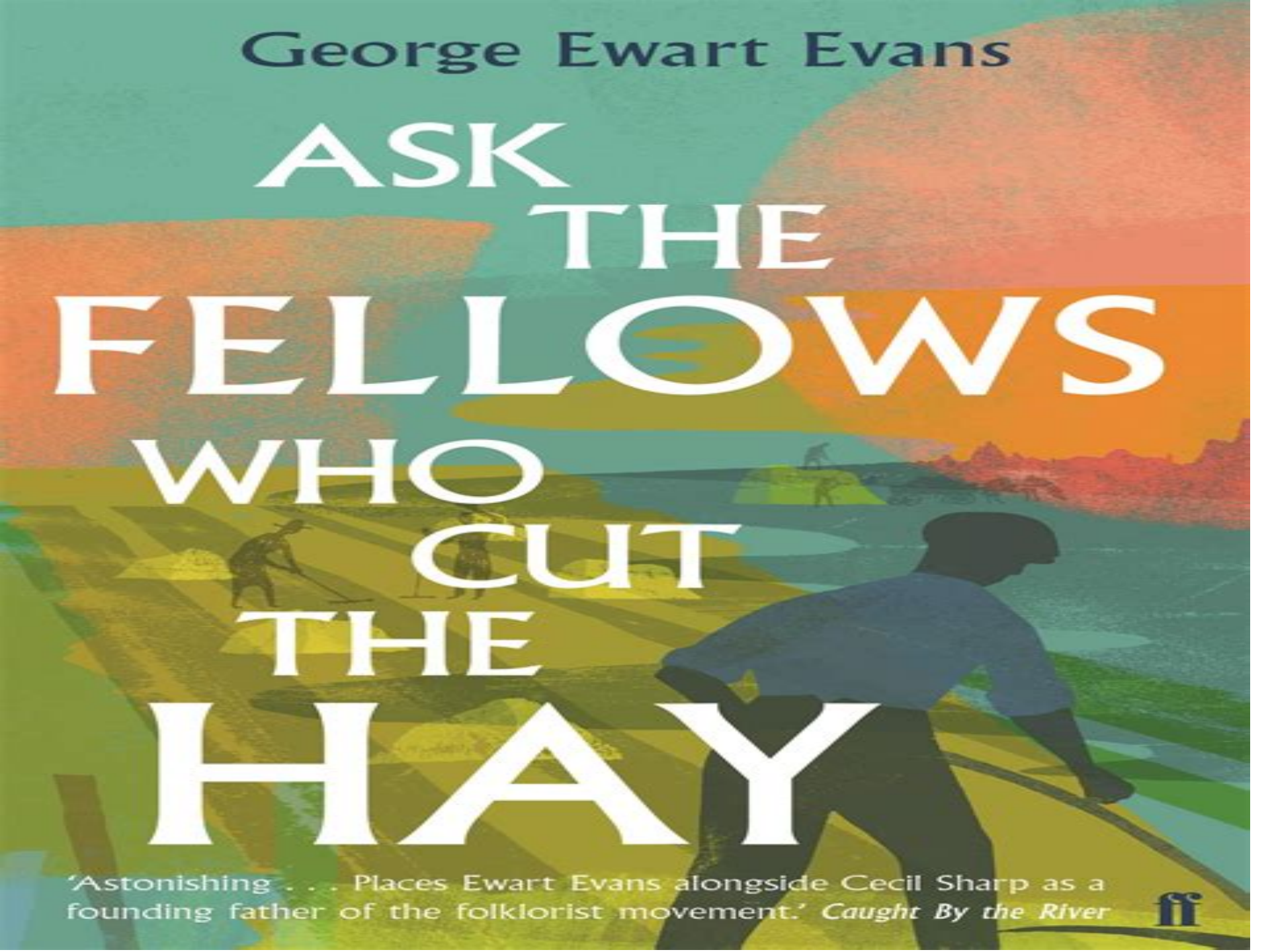

for three years the base of BBC Springwatch and soft dreamy coastal landscapes comprising river estuaries remote marshes reed beds shingle beaches notably Shingle Street with its myth of World War II invasions and dunes Suffolk's coastal towns and villages Southwold with its old fashioned pier and colourful beach huts but also Aldeburgh Orford Walberswick and Dunwich are steeped in art heritage with links to artists including Maggi Hambling John Piper Philip Wilson Steer and Charles Rennie Mackintosh Venturing inland you can make for Constable Country and the Stour valley Bury St Edmunds Framlingham Bungay Beccles or Halesworth Alternatively you can visit some of Suffolk's wealth of medieval churches learn of Rendlesham's UFOs or revere Suffolk's Anglo Saxon heritage notably the medieval ceremonial burial site at Sutton Hoo whose discovery stars in the 2021 film The Dig and the reconstructed Anglo Saxon village at West Stow This guide makes a virtue of being selective pointing readers to the cream of the area It is organised into locales to encourage stay put tourism and thorough exploration It suggests options for car free travel walking cycling river boats buses and trains Written in an entertaining yet authoritative style Bradt's Suffolk Slow Travel is the ideal companion with which to discover this county

Folk Life, 1985 A journal of ethnological studies **A History of Childhood** Colin Heywood, 2013-05-02 In this lively and accessible book Colin Heywood explores the changing experiences and perceptions of childhood from the early Middle Ages to the beginning of the twentieth century Heywood examines the different ways in which people have thought about childhood as a stage of life the relationships of children with their families and peers and the experiences of young people at work in school and at the hands of various welfare institutions The aim is to place the history of children and childhood firmly in its social and cultural context without losing sight of the many individual experiences that have come down to us in diaries autobiographies and oral testimonies Heywood argues that there is a cruel paradox at the heart of childhood in the past On the one hand material conditions for children have generally improved in the West however belatedly and unevenly and they are now more valued than in the past On the other hand the business of preparing for adulthood has become more complicated in urban and industrial societies as the young face a bewildering array of choices and expectations A History of Childhood will be an essential introduction to the subject for students of history the social sciences and cultural studies

Informal Justice in England and Wales, 1760-1914 Stephen Banks, 2014 Shortlisted for the 2015 Katharine Briggs Award This is a study of law wrongdoing and justice as conceived in the minds of the ordinary people of England and Wales from the later eighteenth century to the First World War Official justice was to become increasingly centralised with declining traditional courts emerging professional policing and a new prison estate However popular concepts of what was or should be contained within the law were often at variance with its formal written content Communities continued to hold mock courts stage shaming processions and burn effigies of wrongdoers The author investigates those justice rituals the actors the victims and the offences that occasioned them He also considers the role such practices played in resistive communities trying to preserve their identity and assert their independence Finally whilst documenting the decline of

popular justice traditions this book demonstrates that they were nevertheless important in bequeathing a powerful set of symbols and practices to the nascent labour movement This book will be of interest to scholars and students of legal history and criminal justice as well as social and cultural history in what could be considered a very long nineteenth century Stephen Banks is an associate professor in criminal law criminal justice and legal history at the University of Reading co director of the Forum for Legal and Historical Research and author of *A Polite Exchange of Bullets The Duel and the English Gentleman 1750 1850* The Boydell Press 2010 *Ask the Fellows who Cut the Hay.
