Rights South , With essays by Tony Badger David L Chappell Elizabeth Jacoway Richard H King Ralph E Luker Charles Marsh Keith D Miller Linda Reed and Lauren F Winner In the 1950s and 1960s the American South was in upheaval Brilliant thinkers and writers joined on the ground activists to challenge segregation and the South's long established Jim Crow society The men and women who opposed them waged a war of words in favor of the status quo The essays in The Role of Ideas in the Civil Rights South examine the interplay of thought and action in a complex and turbulent moment in American history Written by scholars in history English and religious studies these essays explore ideas about religion freedom race liberalism and conservatism When people challenged authority or defended it what ideas did they uphold What were their moral and intellectual standards What language did they use and what sources did they cite What issues did they feel needed explaining what issues did they take for granted and what issues did they avoid Leading scholars investigate the wide range of conceptions interpretations and responses to the whirlwind of change Some of the essays concentrate on intellectuals who

Carter,2012-09-01 After the passage of sweeping civil rights and voting rights legislation in 1964 and 1965 the civil rights movement stood poised to build on considerable momentum In a famous speech at Howard University in 1965 President Lyndon B Johnson declared that victory in the next battle for civil rights would be measured in equal results rather than equal rights and opportunities It seemed that for a brief moment the White House and champions of racial equality shared the same objectives and priorities Finding common ground proved elusive however in a climate of growing social and political unrest marked by urban riots the Vietnam War and resurgent conservatism Examining grassroots movements and organizations and their complicated relationships with the federal government and state authorities between 1965 and 1968 David C Carter takes readers through the inner workings of local civil rights coalitions as they tried to maintain strength within their organizations while facing both overt and subtle opposition from state and federal officials He also highlights internal debates and divisions within the White House and the executive branch demonstrating that the federal government s relationship to the movement and its major goals was never as clear cut as the president s progressive rhetoric suggested Carter reveals the complex and often tense relationships between the Johnson administration and activist groups advocating further social change and he extends the traditional timeline of the civil rights movement beyond the passage of the Voting Rights Act **Lift Every Voice** Lani Guinier,1998 In 1993 shortly

after his inauguration new President Bill Clinton nominated his old friend and classmate Lani Guinier to the prestigious and crucial post of Assistant Attorney General for Civil Rights In the face of concerted opposition what one friend of Guinier s called a low tech lynching Clinton backed down not only withdrawing her nomination but having refused throughout to give her an opportunity to speak out in her own defense and his The result was a civil rights setback of monumental proportions Now in this book at once a memoir and insider s account of what really happened behind the closed doors of the Oval Office the Justice Department and the U S Senate and an insightful look at the past present and future of civil rights in America Lani Guinier at last breaks her silence Unsparing of her own mistakes and shrewdly perceptive about the overt and hidden agendas of those who opposed her Professor Guinier shows how the president promptly abandoned his ambitious agenda for civil rights at the first hint of criticism from the media and Congress and how the civil rights movement suffered a major setback as a result Above all Guinier goes on to describe how her experience at the hands of the press the White House and her congressional enemies has given her both a new voice and a renewed faith in the ongoing struggle for civil rights Using her own nomination as a symbolic point of reference she shows just how weak and divided the cause of civil rights has become as its leaders have all too often been silenced by the very people they should be challenging The Cotton Plantation South Since the Civil War Charles S. Resolving Racial Conflict Bertram J. Levine, 2005 In 1964 when the Civil Rights Act was passed Congress wisely created an agency based in the U S Department of Justice to help forestall or resolve racial or ethnic disputes evolving from the act Mandated by law and by its own methodology to shun publicity the Community Relations Service developed self effacement to a fine art Thus the accomplishments as well as the shortcomings of this federal venture into conflict resolution are barely known in official Washington and even less so by the American public This first written history of the Community Relations Service uses the experiences of the men and women who sought to resolve the most volatile issues of the day to tell the fascinating story of this unfamiliar agency This multiracial cadre of conciliation and mediation specialists worked behind the scenes in more than 20 000 confrontations involving racial and ethnic minorities From Selma to Montgomery at the encampment of the Poor Peoples Campaign in Resurrection City to the urban riots of the sixties seventies and eighties from the school desegregation battles north and south at the siege of Wounded Knee and during the Texas Gulf Coast fishing wars between Southeast Asian refugees and Anglos these federal peacemakers lessened the atmosphere of racial violence in every major U S city and thousands of small towns These confrontations ranged from disputes that attracted worldwide attention to the everyday affronts assaults and upheavals that marked the nation s adjustment to wider power sharing within an
