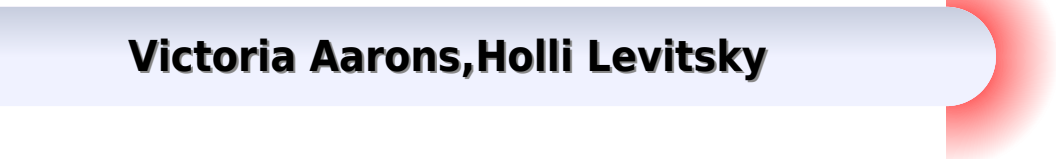

Black Milk:
