Black Music in the Harlem Renaissance Samuel A. Floyd, 1990-06-11 By the mid 1920s the Harlem Renaissance was underway As an effort to secure economic social and cultural equality with white citizens the Renaissance years were a proving period for black composers and performers Black Music in the Harlem Renaissance explores black music in the United States and England during the 1920s and its relationship to other arts of the time The first collection on the subject Black Music in the Harlem Renaissance seeks to revise previous assumptions about music during this era The book features essays on various subjects including musical theatre Duke Ellington black music and musicians in England concert singers and the interrelationships between black painters and music In addition the book includes a music bibliography of works composed during the period

The Black Chicago Renaissance Darlene Clark Hine, John McCluskey, 2012-06-25 The New Negro consciousness with its roots in the generation born in the last and opening decades of the 19th and 20th centuries replenished and nurtured by migration resulted in the Harlem Renaissance in the 1920s then reemerged transformed in the 1930s as the Black Chicago Renaissance The authors in this volume argue that beginning in the 1930s and lasting into the 1950s Black Chicago experienced a cultural renaissance that rivaled the cultural outpouring in Harlem The Black Chicago Renaissance however has not received its full due This book addresses that neglect Like Harlem Chicago had become a major destination for black southern migrants Unlike Harlem it was also an urban industrial center that gave a unique working class and internationalist perspective to the cultural work that took place here The contributors to Black Chicago Renaissance analyze a prolific period of African American creativity in music performance art social science scholarship and visual and literary artistic expression Each author discusses forces that distinguished and link the Black Chicago Renaissance to the Harlem Renaissance as well as placing the development of black culture in a national and international context by probing the histories of multiple sequential and overlapping Philadelphia Cleveland Detroit Los Angeles Memphis black renaissances Among the topics discussed in this volume are Chicago writers Gwendolyn Brooks and Richard Wright The Chicago Defender and Tivoli Theater African American music and visual arts as well as the American Negro Exposition of 1940

Racial Uplift and American Music, 1878-1943 Lawrence Schenbeck, 2012-02-03 Racial Uplift and American Music 1878 1943 traces the career of racial uplift ideology as a factor in elite African Americans embrace of classical music around the turn of the previous century from the collapse of Reconstruction to the death of composer conductor R Nathaniel Dett whose music epitomized uplift After Reconstruction many black leaders had retreated from emphasizing inalienable rights to a narrower rationale for equality and inclusion they now sought to rehabilitate the race s image by stressing class distinctions respectable middle class behavior and service to the masses Musically the black intelligentsia resorted to European models as vehicles for cultural vindication Their response to racism was to create and promote morally positive politically inoffensive art that idealized the race By incorporating black folk elements into the dignified genres of art song symphony and opera uplifters demonstrated worthiness through high achievement in acknowledged arenas Their efforts were variously opposed tolerated or supported by a range of white elites with their own notions about African American culture The resulting conversation more a stew of arguments than a dialogue occupied the pages of black newspapers and informed the work of white philanthropists Women also played crucial roles

Racial Uplift and American Music 1878 1943 examines the lives and thought of personalities central to musical uplift Dett Sears CEO Julius Rosenwald author James Monroe Trotter sociologist W E B Du Bois journalist Nora Douglas Holt and others with an eye to recognizing their contributions and restoring their stature

Spirituals Kathleen A. Abromeit, 2015-01-01 Spirituals originated among enslaved Africans in America during the colonial era They resonate throughout African American history from that time to the civil rights movement from the cotton fields to the concert stage and influenced everything from gospel music to blues and rap They have offered solace in times of suffering served as clandestine signals on the Underground Railroad and been a source of celebration and religious inspiration Spirituals are born from the womb of African American experience yet they transcend national disciplinary and linguistic boundaries as they connect music theology literature and poetry history society and education In doing so they reach every aspect of human experience To make sense of the immense impact spirituals have made on music culture and society this bibliography cites writings from a multidisciplinary perspective This annotated bibliography documents articles books and dissertations published since 1902 Of those 150 are books 80 are chapters within books 615 are journal articles and 150 are dissertations along with a selection of highly significant items published before 1920 The most recent publications included date from early 2014 Disciplines researched include music literature and poetry American history religion and African American Studies Items included in the annotated bibliography are limited to English language sources that were published in the United States and focus on African American spirituals in the United States but there are a few select citations that focus on spirituals outside of the United States Of the one thousand annotations they are divided roughly evenly between general studies and geographical studies

information about early spirituals use of spirituals in art music church music and popular music composers who based music on spirituals performers of spirituals ensembles and individuals Bible theology and religious education literature and poetry pedagogical considerations including the teaching of spirituals as well as prominent educators reference works and a list of resources that were unavailable for review but are potentially useful This book also offers considerable depth on particular topics such as the Fisk Jubilee Singers and William Grant Still with over thirty citations devoted to each At the same time materials included are quite diverse with topics such as spirituals in Zora Neale Hurston's novels bible studies based on spirituals enriching the teaching of geography through spirituals Marian Anderson's historic concert at the Lincoln Memorial spiritual roots of rap teaching dialect to singers expressing African American religion in spirituals Samuel Coleridge Taylor's music slave tradition of singing among the Gullah The book contains indices by author subject and spiritual title Additionally an appendix of spirituals by biblical reference listing both spiritual title to scriptural reference as well as scripture to spiritual title is included T L Collins Christian educator compiled the appendix

times and locates important intersections where music history politics and literature meet Jimoh carefully distinguishes among the different musical forms and shows how in fiction they are transformed into rich metaphors She explains for example how characters and themes drawing on the Spiritual Gospel tradition de emphasize human agency depicting earthly survival as a transitory state and heavenly triumph as a victory By contrast in Blues fiction characters must often negotiate an environment of alienation change and uncertainty in order to achieve a more earthly triumph even if that triumph is only survival Jazz fiction meanwhile goes beyond Blues and Spiritual expressions to explore new realms revealing a space for infinite options radical change resistance and revolution This innovative book examines novels that have not previously received extensive attention including Albert Murray s *Train Whistle Guitar* Wallace Thurman s *The Blacker the Berry* and Ann Petry s *The Street* At the same time it brings fresh and intriguing readings to such widely studied works as Ellison s *Invisible Man* and Morrison s *Sula* Finally it suggests some exciting directions for future study as new generations of African American musicians and writers continue to develop and expand on established traditions and forms The Author A Yemisi Jimoh is an associate professor of English at the University of Arkansas Fayetteville Her articles have appeared in *African American Review* *Contemporary African American Novelists* and other publications
