To respond to their protests, in March 1969, the Board of Governors passed a dramatically new and controversial policy to encourage disadvantaged students who lived in Camden, Newark, and New Brunswick to apply to Rutgers, where they would take college preparatory classes as

unmatriculated students and then enter Rutgers as matriculated students This program never very successful lasted only two years Unrest did not end with the sixties During the seventies black students sporadically voiced protests against what they perceived to be an unsupportive environment During the eighties black enrollment actually declined as did the black graduation rate In conclusion McCormick points to the effort that has been made but even more to the effort that still needs to be made and the social cost of ignoring the problem
