distinctive cultural groups that already existed in Texas prior to its statehood or that came to Texas in the early twentieth century The Indian Texans The Mexican Texans The European Texans The African Texans and The Asian Texans *She Hath Been Reading* Katherine West Scheil,2012-05-15 In the late nineteenth century hundreds of clubs formed across the United States devoted to the reading of Shakespeare From Pasadena California to the seaside town of Camden Maine from the isolated farm town of Ottumwa Iowa to Mobile Alabama on the Gulf coast Americans were reading Shakespeare in astonishing numbers and in surprising places Composed mainly of women these clubs offered the opportunity for members not only to read and study Shakespeare but also to participate in public and civic activities outside the home In *She Hath Been Reading* Katherine West Scheil uncovers this hidden layer of intellectual activity that flourished in American society well into the twentieth century Shakespeare clubs were crucial for women s intellectual development because they provided a consistent intellectual stimulus more so than was the case with most general women s clubs and because women discovered a world of possibilities both public and private inspired by their reading of Shakespeare Indeed gathering to read and discuss Shakespeare often led women to actively improve their lot in life and make their society a better place Many clubs took action on larger social issues such as women s suffrage philanthropy and civil rights At the same time these efforts served to embed Shakespeare into American culture as a marker for learning self improvement civilization and entertainment for a broad array of populations varying in age race location and social standing Based on extensive research in the archives of the Folger Shakespeare Library and in dozens of local archives and private collections across America *She Hath Been Reading* shows the important role that literature can play in the lives of ordinary people As testament to this fact the book includes an appendix listing more than five hundred Shakespeare clubs across America *The Texas Left* David O'Donald Cullen,Kyle G. Wilkison,2010-02-05 *The Texas Left* Some would say the phrase is an oxymoron For most of the twentieth century the popular perception of Texas politics has been that of dominant conservatism punctuated by images of cowboys oil barons and party bosses intent on preserving a decidedly capitalist status quo In fact poor farmers and laborers who were disenfranchised segregated and depending on their ethnicity and gender confronted with varying levels of hostility and discrimination have long composed the other political heritage of Texas In *The Texas Left* fourteen scholars examine this heritage Though largely ignored by historians of previous decades who focused instead on telling the stories of the Alamo the Civil War the cattle drives and the oilfield wildcatters this parallel narrative of those who sought to resist repression reveals themes important to the unfolding history of Texas and the Southwest Volume editors David O Donald Cullen and Kyle G Wilkison have assembled a collection of pioneering studies that provide the broad outlines for future research on liberal and radical social and political causes in the state and region Among the topics explored in this book are early efforts of women blacks Tejanos labor organizers and political activists to claim rights of citizenship livelihood and recognition from the Reconstruction era until recent times **Capitol Women** Nancy Baker Jones,Ruthe Winegarten,2010-07-22 Along with bar

rooms and bordellos there has hardly been a more male focused institution in Texas history than the Texas Legislature Yet the eighty six women who have served there have made a mark on the institution through the legislation they have passed much of which addresses their concerns as citizens who have been inadequately represented by male lawmakers This first complete record of the women of the Texas Legislature places such well known figures as Kay Bailey Hutchison Sissy Farenthold Barbara Jordan Irma Rangel Eddie Bernice Johnson Susan Combs and Judith Zaffirini in the context of their times and among the women and men with whom they served Drawing on years of primary research and interviews Nancy Baker Jones and Ruthe Winegarten offer concise biographies and profiles of all eighty six women who have served or currently hold office in the Texas Legislature The biographies describe the women lawmakers lives campaign strategies and legislative successes and defeats Four introductory essays provide historical and cultural context for the biographies which are arranged chronologically to give a sense of the passage of time of relationships among and between women and of the issues of their eras

Tuneful Tales Bernice Love Wiggins, 2002 As enigmatic and contradictory as far West Texas has always been it is nevertheless surprising to learn that in 1925 its desert germinated a slender but vibrant shoot of the Harlem Renaissance Isolated on the U S Mexico border far from any metropolitan African American community or literary influences Bernice Love Wiggins a perceptive young poet self published her first apparently only book of poetry One of only a handful of black writers in Texas in the 1920s and 1930s Wiggins was contemporary with Langston Hughes Countee Cullen and Zora Neale Hurston and was among the first female African American poets published in the United States Just as the Harlem movement focused on experiences of black Americans who sought relief from racism and endeavored to build communities *Tuneful Tales* gives voice to the many sided black experience in remote El Paso Whatever Wiggins may have known of her contemporaries more than half a continent away or of the movement itself may never be clear Disappointingly after her move to California in the early 1930s the trail grows cold Yet the composed young woman who gazes so wisely if dreamily from her high school photographs evoked her personae so compellingly in both timbre and substance that great folklorist and critic J Mason Brewer proclaimed her the female Paul Laurence Dunbar Ethiopia Speaks Lynched Somewhere in the South the Land of the Free To a very strong branch of a dogwood tree Lynched One of my sons When the flag was in danger they answered the call I gave them black sons ah yes gave them all When you came to me And Now Goodnight I have told you tuneful tales Gathered from the hills and vales Wheresoever mine own people chanced to dwell If the tales have brought you mirth Brought more laughter to the earth It is well Maceo Dailey is the director of the African American Studies Program of the University of Texas El Paso and a governor s appointee to the Texas Council For The Humanities and Juneteenth Commission

Texas Through Women's Eyes Judith N. McArthur, Harold L. Smith, 2010-08-25 Winner Liz Carpenter Award For Research in the History of Women Texas State Historical Association 2010 Texas women broke barriers throughout the twentieth century winning the right to vote expanding their access to higher education entering new professions participating fully in

Liles,Angela Boswell,2016-10-15 Women in Civil War Texas is the first book dedicated to the unique experiences of Texas women during the Civil War It fills the literary void in Texas women s history during this time connects Texas women s lives to southern women s history and shares the diversity of experiences of women in Texas during the Civil War An introductory essay situates the anthology within both Civil War and Texas women s history Contributors explore Texas women and their vocal support for secession and in support of a war coping with their husbands wartime absences the importance of letter writing as a means of connecting families and how pro Union sentiment caused serious difficulties for women They also analyze the effects of ethnicity focusing on African American German and Tejana women s experiences Finally two essays examine the problem of refugee women in east Texas and the dangers facing western frontier women These essays develop the historical understanding of what it meant to be a Texas woman during the Civil War and also contribute to a deeper understanding of the complexity of the war and its effects The Essence of Liberty Wilma King,2006 Before 1865 slavery and freedom coexisted tenuously in America in an environment that made it possible not only for enslaved women to become free but also for emancipated women to suddenly lose their independence Wilma King now examines a wide ranging body of literature to show that even in the face of economic deprivation and draconian legislation many free black women were able to maintain some form of autonomy and lead meaningful lives The Essence of Liberty blends social political and economic history to analyze black women s experience in both the North and the South from the colonial period through emancipation Focusing on class and familial relationships King examines the myriad sources of freedom for black women to show the many factors that along with time spent in slavery before emancipation shaped the meaning of freedom Her book also raises questions about whether free women were bound to or liberated from gender conventions of their day Drawing on a wealth of untapped primary sources not only legal documents and newspapers but also the diaries letters and autobiographical writings of free women King opens a new window on the world of black women She examines how they became free

educated themselves found jobs maintained self esteem and developed social consciousness even participating in the abolitionist movement She considers the stance of southern free women toward their enslaved contemporaries and the interactions between previously free and newly freed women after slavery ended She also looks closely at women s spirituality disclosing the dilemma some women faced when they took a stand against men even black men in order to follow their spiritual callings Throughout this engaging history King underscores the pernicious constraints that racism placed on the lives of free blacks in spite of the fact that they were not enslaved The Essence of Liberty shows the importance of studying these women on their own terms revealing that the essence of freedom is more complex than the mere absence of shackles

Amazing Texas Girls Mary Dodson Wade,2018-04-01 Girls on the Western Frontier were expected to care for younger children cook and clean wash clothes milk cows tend gardens and round up wandering herds in a harsh and unfamiliar landscape Their stories often taken from their first hand accounts of trips on Western trails and journals kept during their few free hours have been inspiring generations of young women and entertaining readers of all ages Amazing Texas Girls tells the stories of notable girls who spent most or all of their childhood in Texas And shaped the history of the Lone Star State Although from different cultures economic status education and notoriety all displayed an indomitable Texas spirit Each chapter tells the story of a girl s life 17 years old or younger offering complete biographical information but focusing on the girl s remarkable childhood Readers will never forget these stories of real girls who conquered the West in their own style

African Americans on the Great Plains Bruce A. Glasrud,Charles A. Braithwaite,2009-10-01 Until recently histories of the American West gave little evidence of the presence let alone importance of African Americans in the unfolding of the western frontier There might have been a mention of Estevan slavery or the Dred Scott decision but the rich and varied experience of African Americans on the Great Plains went largely unnoted This book the first of its kind supplies that critical missing chapter in American history Originally published over the span of twenty five years in Great Plains Quarterly the essays collected here describe the part African Americans played in the frontier army and as homesteaders community builders and activists The authors address race relations discrimination and violence They tell of the struggle for civil rights and against Jim Crow and they examine African American cultural growth and contributions as well as economic and political aspects of black life on the Great Plains From individuals such as Pap Singleton Era Bell Thompson Aaron Douglas and Alphonso Trent to incidents at Fort Hays Brownsville and Topeka to defining moments in government education and the arts this collection offers the first comprehensive overview of the black experience on the Plains

True Women and Westward Expansion Adrienne Caughfield,2005-03-29 Expansion was the fever of the early nineteenth century and women burned with it as surely as men although in a different way Subscribing to the cult of true womanhood which valued domesticity piety and similar feminine virtues women championed expansion for the cause of civilization even while largely avoiding the masculine world of politics Adrienne Caughfield mines the diaries and letters of some ninety Texas women to

uncover the ideas and enthusiasms they brought to the Western frontier Although there were a few notable exceptions most of them drew on their domestic skills and values to establish not only civilization but their own security Caughtfield sheds light on women s activism the flip side of domesticity attitudes toward race and civilization the tie between a vision of a unified continent and a cultivated wilderness and republican values She offers a new understanding of not only gender roles in the West but also the impulse for expansionism itself In Texas Caughtfield demonstrates women never stopped arriving with more fuel for the flames of expansionism as their families tried to find a place to settle down some place with a little more room where national destiny and personal dreams merged into a glorious whole In doing so Texas women expanded not only American borders but their own as well
