The Postwar African American Novel Stephanie Brown, 2011-03-14 Americans in the World War II era bought the novels of African American writers in unprecedented numbers But the names on the books lining shelves and filling barracks trunks were not the now familiar Richard Wright and Ralph Ellison but Frank Yerby Chester Himes William Gardner Smith and J Saunders Redding In this book Stephanie Brown recovers the work of these innovative novelists overturning conventional wisdom about the writers of the period and the trajectory of African American literary history She also questions the assumptions about the relations between race and genre that have obscured the importance of these once influential creators Wright's Native Son 1940 is typically considered to have inaugurated an era of social realism in African American literature And Ellison's Invisible Man 1952 has been cast as both a high mark of American modernism and the only worthy stopover on the way to the Black Arts Movement of the 1960s But readers in the late 1940s purchased enough copies of Yerby's historical romances to make him the best selling African American author of all time Critics meanwhile were taking note of the generic experiments of Redding Himes and Smith while the authors themselves questioned the obligation of black authors to write protest instead penning campus novels war novels and in Yerby's case costume dramas Their status as lesser lights is the product of retrospective bias Brown demonstrates and their novels established the period immediately following World War II as a pivotal moment in the history of the African American novel Psychoanalysis and Black Novels Claudia Tate, 1998 The author of this text argues that psychoanalytic paradigms can produce rich readings of African American desire alienation and subjectivity The Coupling Convention: Sex, Text, and Tradition in Black Women's **Fiction** Ann duCille Associate Professor of English and African American Studies Wesleyan University, 1993-10-19 What does the tradition of marriage mean for people who have historically been deprived of its legal status Generally thought of as a convention of the white middle class the marriage plot has received little attention from critics of African American literature In this study Ann duCille uses texts such as Nella Larsen's Ouicksand 1928 and Zora Neale Hurston's Their Eyes Were Watching God 1937 to demonstrate that the African American novel like its European and Anglo American counterparts has developed around the marriage plot what she calls the coupling convention Exploring the relationship between racial ideology and literary and social conventions duCille uses the coupling convention to trace the historical development of the African American women s novel She demonstrates the ways in which black women appropriated this novelistic device as a means of expressing and reclaiming their own identity More than just a study of the marriage tradition in black women s fiction however The Coupling Convention takes up and takes on many different meanings of tradition It challenges the notion of a single black literary tradition or of a single black feminist literary canon grounded in specifically black female language and experience as it explores the ways in which white and black male and female mainstream and marginalized traditions and canons have influenced and cross fertilized each other Much more than a period study The Coupling Convention spans

Watorczyk, 2005-09-26 Inhaltsangabe Abstract African American Chinese American and Mexican American female adolescents are representatives of minority groups in the United States The three groups of ethnic girls were assigned derogative stereotypes by many Euro American writers who did not portray their characters authentically The modern female ethnic authors undertake the battle with stereotypes that are the main source of girls problems They attempt to convince the reader that the lives of young girls cannot be interpreted according to offending images imposed on them This thesis aims to draw attention to the problems encountered by female ethnic adolescents in Toni Morrison's The Bluest Eye 1970 Maxine Hong Kingston's The Woman Warrior 1976 Sandra Cisneros The House on Mango Street 1984 and to portray their survival or collapse in American society Each of the books presented in the present study is a masterpiece of great literary value Toni Morrison was awarded the Nobel Prize for literature in 1993 Sandra Cisneros was the winner of the 1985 Before Columbus American Book Award Maxine Kingston won the National Book Critics Award with The Woman Warrior which was designated as non fiction in 1976 All of these books contribute significantly to the study of ethnic female adolescents The books chosen for the purpose of this thesis portray girls in an adolescent period The adolescents presented in this study are aged between ten and twenty one and are socially economically and politically dependent on their parents or quardians To further complicate matters the experiences of girls of colour are more complex than those encountered by white adolescents As the typical conflicts within the family problems with gender sexual development education and friends are juxtaposed with issues of racism and very often a lower social status In the light of these facts it does not come as a surprise that many ethnic adolescent girls have problems finding their self The first section of the initial chapter of this thesis takes into consideration the stereotypical image of Euro American adolescent girl as it often serves as a contradiction of the popular images of ethnic girls Furthermore the chapter examines stereotypes of African American Chinese American and Mexican American adolescents Despite their variety the stereotypes are the cause of girls victimisation in society The five following chapters analyse the problems more often
