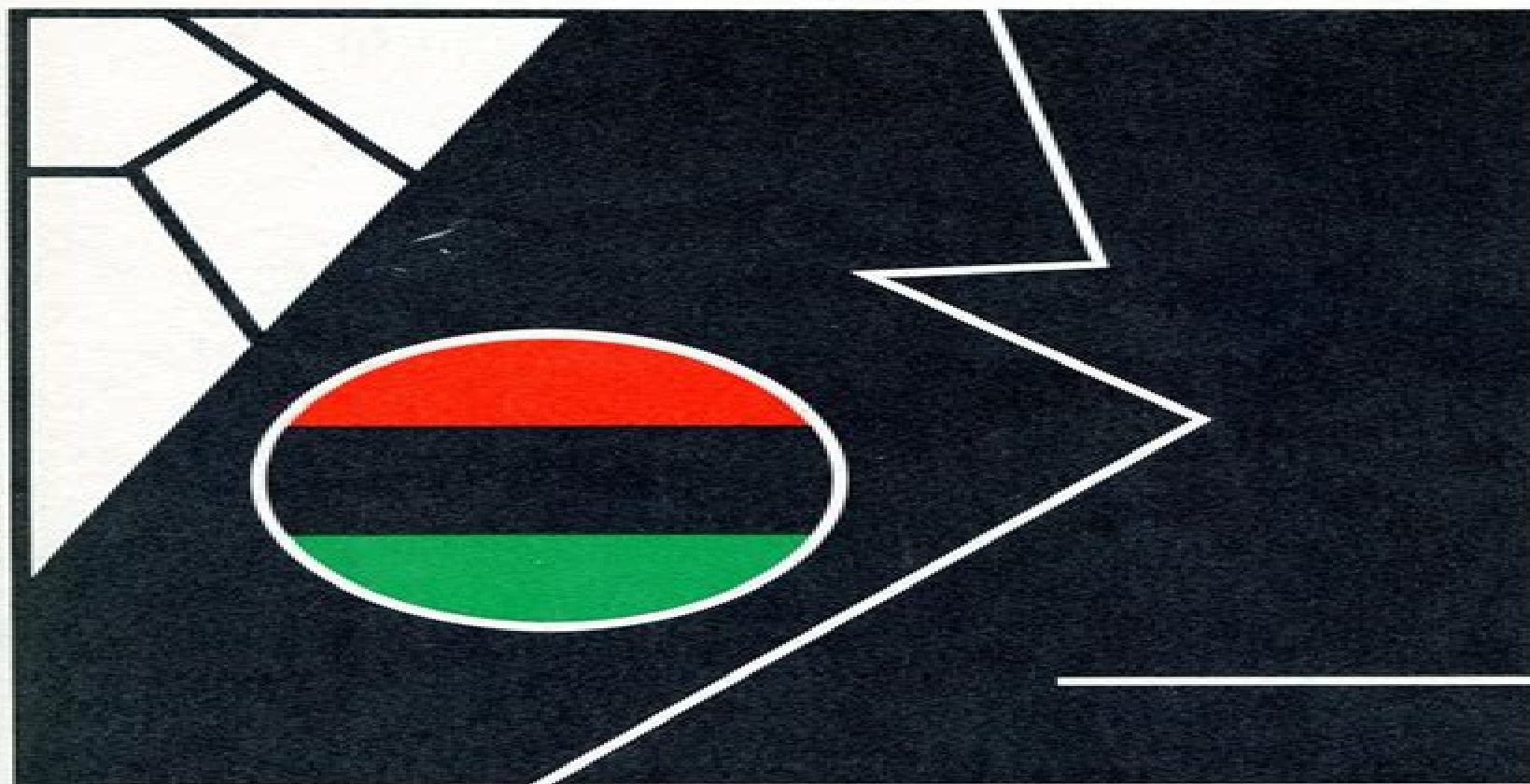

Black Protest Thought in the Twentieth Century August Meier, 1971 **The Other Black Bostonians** Violet M. Johnson, 2006-12-06 This study of Boston's West Indian immigrants examines the identities, goals, and aspirations of two generations of black migrants from the British-held Caribbean who settled in Boston between 1900 and 1950. Describing their experience among Boston's American-born blacks and in the context of the city's immigrant history, the book charts new conceptual territory. *The Other Black Bostonians* explores the pre-migration background of the immigrants, work and housing, identity, culture, and community activism, and social mobility. What emerges is a detailed picture of black immigrant life. Johnson's work makes a contribution to the study of the black diaspora as it charts the history of this first wave of Caribbean immigrants.

Confronting the Veil Jonathan Scott Holloway, 2003-04-23 In this book Jonathan Holloway explores the early lives and careers of economist Abram Harris Jr., sociologist E. Franklin Frazier, and political scientist Ralph Bunche, three black scholars who taught at Howard University during the New Deal and together formed the leading edge of American social science radicalism. Harris, Frazier, and Bunche represented the vanguard of the young black radical intellectual activists who dared to criticize the NAACP for its cautious civil rights agenda and saw in the turmoil of the Great Depression an opportunity to advocate class-based solutions to what were commonly considered racial problems. Despite the broader approach, they called for both their advocates and their detractors had difficulty seeing them as anything but black intellectuals speaking on black issues. A social and intellectual history of the trio of Howard University and of black Washington, *Confronting the Veil* investigates the effects of racialized thinking on Harris, Frazier, Bunche, and others who wanted to think beyond race, who envisioned a workers' movement that would eliminate racial divisiveness, and who used social science to demonstrate the ways in which race is constructed by social phenomena. Ultimately, the book sheds new light on how people have used race to constrain the possibilities of radical politics and social science thinking.

Jordan, 2003-01-14 During World War I the publishers of America's crusading black newspapers faced a difficult dilemma: Would it be better to advance the interests of African Americans by affirming their patriotism and offering support of President Wilson's war for democracy in Europe, or should they demand that the government take concrete steps to stop the lynching, segregation, and disfranchisement of blacks at home as a condition of their participation in the war? This study of their efforts to resolve that dilemma offers important insights into the nature of black protest, race relations, and the role of the press in a republican system. William Jordan shows that before, during, and after the war the black press engaged in a delicate and dangerous dance with the federal government and white America, at times making demands or holding firm, sometimes pledging loyalty, occasionally giving in. But although others have argued that the black press compromised too much, Jordan demonstrates that given the circumstances, its strategic combination of protest and accommodation was remarkably effective.
