Over time, with massive conversions to the faith of their enslavers, Black people's Christian religious experiences would articulate a response to the world that held them in thrall. That response would be articulated most consistently and effectively through their understanding of the cross of Christ. Williams affirms Howard Thurman's claim that by some amazing but vastly creative spiritual insight, the slave undertook the redemption of a religion that the master had profaned in his midst.
