Black Shawl Poems:

Black Shawl Kathryn Stripling Byer, 1998-03-01 *Black Shawl* emanates from Kathryn Stripling Byer's fascination with female ballad singers in southern Appalachia whose voices haunt the mountains still and from the image of a black net or shawl being dragged over the ground plumbing the depths collecting bits and fragments of a woman's life. The singers and storytellers of this splendid collection are struggling to answer the query of the book's epigraph: What will you make of this? The first section *Voices* offers a variety of female perspectives: those of mothers, daughters, sisters, lovers. These women are singing the old songs and waiting for their lives to change. *Blood Mountain*, the second part, experiments with ballad conventions and the mysteries of mythmaking: one story's good as another so long as there's blood in it. Delphia, a quilter and teacher who narrates the third section of *Black Shawl*, epitomizes these mountain women: the very ones who became the Keepers of the Ballads, the repositories and who passed down their knowledge. Through the remarkable mountain women of *Black Shawl*, Byer portrays the singers once mute, finding their place weaving a thread in the web of their existence and its endlessly evolving pattern.

The House is Made of Poetry Wendy Barker, Sandra M. Gilbert, 1996 Ruth Stone has always eschewed self-promotion and in the words of Leslie Fiedler has never been a member of any school or clique or gaggle of mutual admirers. But her poems speak so vibrantly for her that she cannot be ignored. In her preface to this volume Sandra M. Gilbert declares that Stone's intense attention to the ordinary transforms it into or reveals it as the extraordinary. Her passionate verses evoke impassioned responses. At the same time Gilbert continues the essays collected here consistently testify to Stone's radical unworldliness, in particular her insouciant contempt for the floor walkers and straw bosses who sometimes seem to control the poetry factory both inside and outside the university. Wendy Barker and Sandra Gilbert have organized the book into three sections: *Knowing Ruth Stone: A Life of Art and Reading Ruth Stone*. In *Knowing Ruth Stone*, writers of different generations who have known the poet over the years provide memoirs. Noting Stone's singularity, Fiedler points out that she resists all labels and is one of the few contemporaries whom it is possible to think of simply as a poet. Sharon Olds defines her vitality: A Ruth Stone poem feels alive in the hands. And Jan Freeman praises her aesthetic intensity. Everything in the life of Ruth Stone is integrated with poetry. *A Life of Art* sketches the outlines of Stone's career and traces her evolution as a poet. Barker and Norman Friedman, for example, trace her development from the high spirits and elegant craft of her first volume *In an Iridescent Time* through the deepening shadows, poignant wit, and bittersweet meditations of her later work. In interviews separated by decades, one in the 1970s and one in the 1990s, Sandra Gilbert and Robert Bradley discuss with Stone her own sense of her aesthetic origins and literary growth. *Reading Ruth Stone* is an examination of Stone's key themes and modes. Diane Wakoski and Diana O. Hehir focus on the tragicomic vision that colors much of her work. Kevin Clark and Elyse Blankley explore the political aspects of her poetry. Roger Gilbert analyzes her often uncannily astute insights into the otherness of other lives. Janet Lowery and Kandace Brill Lombart draw on the biographical background of Stone's

Reinventing Romantic Poetry Diana Greene, 2004-01-15 *Reinventing Romantic Poetry* offers a new look at the Russian literary scene in the nineteenth century. While celebrated poets such as Aleksandr Pushkin worked within a male-centered Romantic aesthetic, the poet as a bard or sexual conqueror, nature as a mother or mistress, the poet's muse as an idealized woman, Russian women attempting to write Romantic poetry found they had to reinvent poetic conventions of the day to express themselves as women and as poets. Comparing the poetry of fourteen men and fourteen women from this period, Diana Greene revives and redefines the women's writings and offers a thoughtful examination of the sexual politics of reception and literary reputation. The fourteen women considered wrote poetry in every genre, from visions to verse tales, from love lyrics to metaphysical

poetry as well as prose works and plays Greene delves into the reasons why their writing was dismissed focusing in particular on the work of Evdokiia Rostopchina Nadezhda Khvoshchinskaia and Karolina Pavlova Greene also considers class as a factor in literary reputation comparing canonical male poets with the work of other men whose work like the women's was deemed inferior at the time The book also features an appendix of significant poems by Russian women discussed in the text Some found in archival notebooks are published here for the first time and others are reprinted for the first time since the mid nineteenth century
