Williams, 2017 With his novels journalism short stories political activism and travel writing Jack London established himself as one of the most prolific and diverse authors of the twentieth century Covering London's biography cultural context and the various genres in which he wrote *The Oxford Handbook of Jack London* is the definitive reference work on the author *Charmian Kittredge London* Iris Jamahl Dunkle, 2020-09-17 Charmian Kittredge London 1871 1955 was the epitome of a modern woman Free spirited and adventurous she defied modern expectations of femininity Today she is best known as the wife of the famous American author Jack London yet she was a literary trailblazer in her own right This biography is the first book to tell the complete story of Charmian's life freed from the shadow cast by her famous husband In this biography Iris Jamahl Dunkle draws the reader into Charmian's private and public worlds underscoring her literary achievements and the significant role she played in promoting her husband's legacy Her life as Dunkle emphasizes required fortitude and bravery and in many ways it paralleled the history of the American West Born on the mudflats of what would become Los Angeles's harbor Charmian became an orphan at age fourteen Raised by her aunt Netta Wiley Ames a noted writer and editor for the *Overland Monthly* Charmian attended college became an expert equestrian and concert pianist and had a successful career as a stenographer But her life shifted when in 1905 she married Jack London already a bestselling author For the rest of Jack's life until his untimely death at the age of forty reporters would follow the couple's every move Charmian and Jack traveled the world exploring and writing together In addition to collaborating with Jack on many of his projects Charmian wrote three books about her travels as well as countless articles After Jack's death in 1916 she remained a celebrity continuing to travel and write and seek adventure She also wrote a biography about her late husband and managed his estate influencing how Jack's

Queer Compulsions Amy H. Sueyoshi, 2012-02-29. In September 1897 Yone Noguchi (1875-1947) contemplated crafting a poem to his new love, western writer Charles Warren Stoddard. Recently arrived in California, Noguchi was in awe of the established writer and the two had struck up a passionate correspondence. Still, he viewed their relationship as doomed, not by the scandal of their same-sex affections but by their introverted dispositions and differences in background. In a poem dedicated to his dearest Charlie, Noguchi wrote: "Thou and I, O Charles, sit alone like two shy stars, east and west." While confessing his love to Stoddard, Noguchi had a child, future sculptor Isamu Noguchi. With his editor Lonie Gilmour, he became engaged to Washington Post reporter Ethel Armes, and upon his return to Japan, married Matsu Takeda, all within a span of seven years. According to author Amy Sueyoshi, Noguchi was not a dedicated polyamorist. He deliberately deceived the three women to whom he either pretended or promised marriage while already married. She argues further that Noguchi's intimacies point to little-known realities of race and sexuality in turn-of-the-century America and illuminate how Asian immigrants negotiated America's literary and arts community. As Noguchi maneuvered through cultural and linguistic differences, his affairs additionally assert how Japanese in America could forge romantic fulfillment during a period historians describe as one of extreme sexual deprivation and discrimination for Asians, particularly in California. Moreover, Noguchi's relationships reveal how individuals who engaged in seemingly defiant behavior could exist peaceably within prevailing moral mandates. His unexpected intimacies in fact relied upon existing social hierarchies of race, sexuality, gender and nation that dictated appropriate and inappropriate behavior. In fact, Noguchi, Stoddard, Gilmour and Armes at various points contributed to the ideological forces that compelled their intimate lives.
