For as the unknown author of Hebrews declares, Jesus is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being. Hebrews 1:3. It is not the primary purpose of the church to specialize in economic, social, or political issues, but rather to proclaim the good news of what God has accomplished in and through Jesus Christ. When the church quits proclaiming Christ to proclaim a message of love, acceptance, tolerance, and affirmation, then it ceases to effectively fulfill its purpose and loses its relevancy. Christ came into the world to proclaim the Gospel in the marketplace, and He did so while never surrendering His identity or sacrificing His purpose for the sake of relevancy. He expects His church in every age to do likewise. The greatest need in the church today is exactly what the early church needed in the first century. In a church that is infected with a spiritual apathy, has forsaken her first love, has compromised truth, and is lukewarm, a new vision of the risen and glorified Christ dwelling in her midst is needed. The only method God designed to lead the church to recover the awareness of Christ's presence is prayer and preaching that focuses on Jesus Christ. Thus, if the church is to flourish again, there is no greater need than a recovery of faithful, powerful biblical preaching whose subject is Christ and the new birth.

Clark,2024-04-01 While many have recognized unusual patterns of repetition within the book of Hebrews which seem to play a range of important functions within the text the consistency of this patterning has not been fully appreciated and its function has been largely unexamined This study investigates the location and function of what we have termed link clusters within Hebrews from the perspective of discourse analysis to gain fresh insight into the language structure and genre of Hebrews into the book s relationship to the Old Testament and into the book s authorship and meaning This work proposes first that Hebrews uses repetition to establish formal connections between words and phrases marked as significant by their location and context with respect to other similarly connected words and phrases second that link clusters serve to structure the book of Hebrews by uniting the text into a series of overlapping concentric and coherent units and third that link clusters also serve an important topical function clarifying and amplifying intended meaning as pairs of matching topic sentences that respectively introduce and conclude each section and subsection of the discourse by summarizing its content

God himself has brought about the fulfillment of these institutions through his Son's priesthood his once for all sacrifice and the new covenant he inaugurated in the last days These new institutions are never denied the Jews In fact the context of the epistle presumes that these are primarily for the Jews considering that the author was speaking to a Jewish Christian community The author is not arguing for the abandonment by God of the Jewish people but rather for the abandonment of the shadowy means by which God's people drew near to him It is here we can speak of a qualified supersessionism According to the author of Hebrews the Levitical priesthood the Mosaic covenant and the Levitical sacrifices have been superseded by Jesus' priesthood the new covenant and Jesus' once for all sacrifice However we conclude that the polemical passages in Hebrews do not promote hatred of the Jews nor do they advocate the destruction of the Jewish people Rather the author of Hebrews stresses the fulfillment of specific Jewish institutions for the benefit of the Jews It is this idea of fulfillment that rules out the charge that the epistle promotes the supersession of the Jewish people Because of God's great love for his people he has provided a superior way by which his people can draw near to him from the Conclusion
