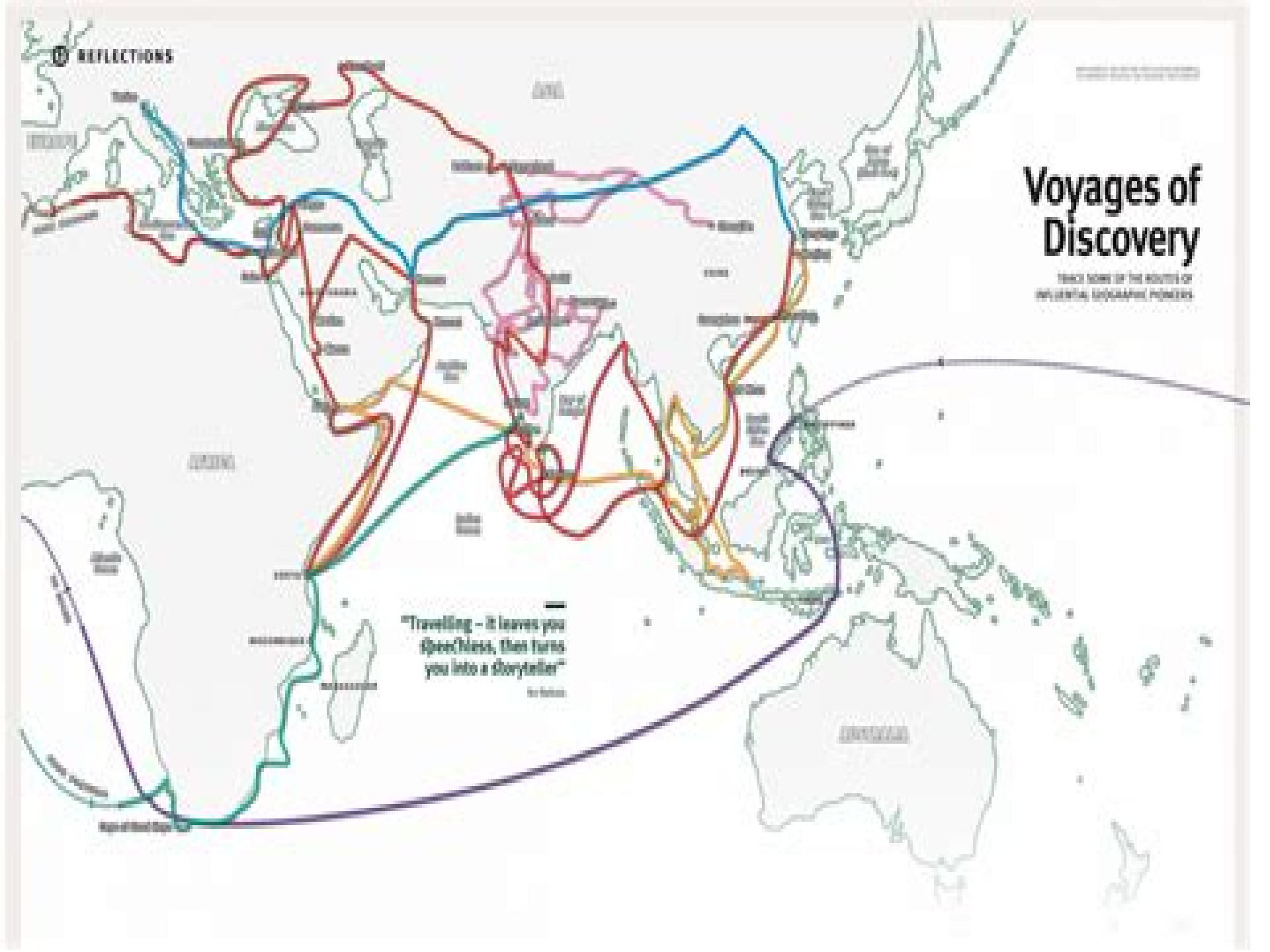

Dathorne, 1996-07-22 O R Dathorne pursues the phenomenon of contact or encounter particularly as it relates to China and the islands of the Pacific Ocean He looks at how the Chinese have perceived their Other as heathen and exotic and how the West has in turn similarly perceived the Chinese The failure of the West to relate to China in human terms is subtly documented and is contrasted to the European experience in the New World and the African encounter of both China and the West Dathorne breaks new ground in his analysis of the construct of the Other on the Pacific Islands Using indigenous oral accounts early texts of European explorers and castaways and imaginative accounts he reconstructs the period of contact from the native viewpoint of those who acted as translators pilots guides chartmakers and male and female companions He calls attention to the Western habit of romancing the place while denigrating or mythologizing the people

chattel that once they had become owned beings they could then be either sold or inherited Yet despite being representative of perhaps the most universalizable human practice of that age slavery in medieval East Asia was also endowed with its own distinctive traits and traditions Our awareness of these features of distinction contributes immeasurably to a more nuanced understanding of slavery as the ubiquitous and openly practiced institution that it once was and the now illicit and surreptitious one that it intractably remains

Dutch Ships in Tropical Waters Robert Parthesius, 2025-10-01 The end of the 16th century saw Dutch expansion in Asia as The Dutch East India Company the VOC was fast becoming an Asian power both political and economic By 1669 the VOC was the richest private company the world had ever seen This landmark study looks at perhaps the most important tool in the Company trading its ships In order to reconstruct the complete shipping activities of the VOC the author created a unique database of the ships movements including frigates and other hitherto ignored smaller vessels Parthesius's research into the routes and the types of ships in the service of the VOC proves that it was precisely the wide range of types and sizes of vessels that gave the Company the ability to sail and continue its profitable trade the year round Furthermore it appears that the VOC commanded at least twice the number of ships than earlier historians have ascertained Combining the best of maritime and social history this book will change our understanding of the commercial dynamics of the most successful economic organization of the period

Sino-French Trade at Canton, 1698-1842 Susan E. Schopp, 2020-11-02 Sino French Trade at Canton 1698 1842 presents a rare and lively view of the French experience at Canton and calls for a reappraisal of France's role in that trade France was one of the two most important Western powers in the eighteenth century and was home to one of the three major European East India companies Yet the nation is woefully underrepresented in Canton trade scholarship Susan E Schopp rescues the French from the sidelines showing that they exerted a presence that though closely watched by their rivals is today largely unrecognized Their contributions were diverse ranging from finding new sea routes to inspiring the renovation of hong fa ades Consequently to ignore the French or to dismiss them as simply also rans results in a skewed perception of the Canton system Schopp also demonstrates that while the most distinctive aspect of the French model of company trade was the dominant role of the state indeed the French East India Company has been memorably described as a Versailles of trade this did not rule out a place for legitimate and sometimes surprising participation by the private sector On the contrary France's commercial relations with China were inaugurated by private traders and the popularity of the Canton trade spurred the eventual demise of the company model Backed up by extensive archival work Schopp's work demonstrates a remarkable understanding of the Sino European trade and her book reveals an unparalleled passion for the role of seamanship in history It is shocking how little has been written in any language about French trade in China so this excellent book fills a tremendous need It has the potential to become a classic monograph of lasting significance an outstanding work
