Kee Pookong, Laksiri Jayasuriya, 2013-04-04 we must combat blind ignorance with fact and unreason with reason and that is what this book is about Don Dunstan Pauline Hanson was not the first person to sensationalise the effects of Australia's open immigration policy on the racial make up of this country Nor was she the first politician to see advantage in building on the fear and prejudice beneath the surface of Australia's multicultural society For the end of the White Australia policy in 1973 did not spell the end of fear of a peaceful Asian invasion through immigration The Asianisation of Australia contributes the dispassionate independent and objective comment that has been missing from media debate on the effects of our immigration policies It provides a wealth of data on the make up of Australia's immigrant intake and the ability of immigrants to establish a place in their new country Recent political rhetoric and forecasts are exposed for the myths prejudices and over simplifications that they are By comparing such indicators as rates of employment income childbirth intermarriage and fluency in English between Asian and other immigrants Professors Jayasuriya and Kee convincingly demonstrate the valuable contribution made by Asian immigrants to our culture and our economy

Triadafilopoulos,2013-03-25 This book considers the origins performance and diffusion of national immigration policies targeting highly skilled immigrants Unlike asylum seekers and immigrants admitted under family reunification streams highly skilled immigrants are typically cast as wanted and welcome as a consequence of their potential economic contribution to the receiving society and putative assimilability Testing the degree to which this assumption holds is the principle aim of this book In contrast to publications which see highly skilled immigration as functional response to labor market needs the book probes the political and sociological dimensions of policy drawing on contributions from an international group of established and new scholars from the fields of history law political science sociology and public policy The book is organized into four parts Part I probes the origins of post WWII immigration policies in Canada Australia and the United States Part II analyzes recent debates on highly skilled immigration policy in the United States whose origins go back to the 1965 Act by Congress which favored family reunification over skilled immigration Part III considers the degree to which highly skilled immigrants are welcome by focusing on the integration trajectories of foreign trained professionals in Canada Paradoxically just as Canada has succeeded in orienting its admissions system more explicitly toward privileging highly educated and skilled professionals highly skilled immigrants have experienced worsening economic outcomes as reflected in rates of unemployment and falling earnings Part IV considers the internationalization of highly skilled immigration policies focusing on Europe s most important immigration countries Germany and Britain As is true in Canada the labor market outcomes for highly skilled immigrants in Europe are disappointing and the final chapter discusses why this is the case and what might be done to improvematters Given its combination of cross disciplinary insights cross national comparisons and empirical richness the book will be of interest to both scholars and policymakers concerned with immigration policy
