**From Privileges to Rights** Simon Middleton, 2011-06-28 *From Privileges to Rights* connects the changing fortunes of tradesmen in early New York to the emergence of a conception of subjective rights that accompanied the transition to a republican and liberal order in eighteenth century America Tradesmen in New Amsterdam occupied a distinct social position and with varying levels of success secured privileges such as a reasonable reward and the exclusion of strangers from their commerce The struggle to maintain these privileges figured in the transition to English rule as well as Leisler s Rebellion Using hitherto unexamined records from the New York City Mayor s Court Simon Middleton also demonstrates that rather than merely mastering skilled crafts in workshops artisans participated in whatever enterprises and markets promised profits with a minimum of risk Bakers butchers and carpenters competed in a bustling urban economy knit together by credit that connected their fortunes to the Atlantic trade In the early eighteenth century political and legal changes diminished earlier social distinctions and the grounds for privileges while an increasing reliance on slave labor stigmatized menial toil When an economic and a constitutional crisis prompted the importation of radical English republican ideas artisans were recast artisans as virtuous male property owners whose consent was essential for legitimate government In this way an artisanal subject emerged that provided a constituency for the development of a populist and egalitarian republican political culture in New York City

**Strangers Within the Realm** Bernard Bailyn, Philip D. Morgan, 2012-12-01 Shedding new light on British expansion in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries this collection of essays examines how the first British Empire was received and shaped by its subject peoples in Scotland Ireland North America and the Caribbean An introduction surveys British imperial historiography and provides a context for the volume as a whole The essays focus on specific ethnic groups Native Americans African Americans Scotch Irish and Dutch and Germans and their relations with the British as well as on the effects of British expansion in particular regions Ireland Scotland Canada and the West Indies A conclusion assesses the impact of the North American colonies on British society and politics Taken together these essays represent a new kind of imperial history one that portrays imperial expansion as a dynamic process in which the outlying areas not only the English center played an important role in the development and character of the Empire The collection interprets imperial history broadly examining it from the perspective of common folk as well as elites and discussing the clash of cultures in addition to political disputes

Davis,2015-05-15 Androboros A Bogographical sic Farce in Three Acts 1715 is universally acknowledged as the first play both written and printed in America Its significance stems not simply from its publication but from its eventual impact Androboros was not just the first of its kind it was also ahead of its time in many ways preceding the harsh political satires and farces of the later eighteenth century by some fifty years The play inadvertently laid the foundation for one of the defining rights of the nation that would eventually emerge some seventy five years later the First Amendment of the Constitution of the United States As a closet drama intended only to be read by close friends and political supporters this play has languished as a minor footnote in American intellectual history Scholarly research published to date has been for the most part inadequate and occasionally inaccurate This study remedies that oversight providing a full analysis as well as an annotated typescript and facsimiles of the original printing from back cover
