Turks brought sweet pastries and other bakery products Central Africa's influence comes from the introduction of cassavas, peanuts and pepper plants that arrived along with the slave trade. In West Africa, the Portuguese, French and British influenced regional cuisines with the introduction of plantains, citrus and pineapples, which are a legacy of slave ship traffic between Africa and North America.
