

Black Jack James Pickett Jones, 1995-07-26 John A Logan called Black Jack by the men he led in Civil War battles from the Henry Donelson campaign through Vicksburg Chattanooga and on to Atlanta was one of the Union Army's most colorful generals Perhaps the most capable of the political generals Logan earned a reputation as a courageous efficient officer rising from regimental to army commander The Era of the Civil War--1820-1876 Louise A.
