Black and Brown in Los Angeles Josh Kun, Laura Pulido, 2014 Black and Brown in Los Angeles is a timely and wide ranging interdisciplinary foray into the complicated world of multiethnic Los Angeles The first book to focus exclusively on the range of relationships and interactions between Latinas/os and African Americans in one of the most diverse cities in the United States the book delivers supporting evidence that Los Angeles is a key place to study racial politics while also providing the basis for broader discussions of multiethnic America Students faculty and interested readers will gain an understanding of the different forms of cultural borrowing and exchange that have shaped a terrain through which African Americans and Latinas/os cross paths intersect move in parallel tracks and engage with a whole range of aspects of urban living Tensions and shared intimacies are recurrent themes that emerge as the contributors seek to integrate artistic and cultural constructs with politics and economics in their goal of extending simple paradigms of conflict cooperation or coalition The book features essays by historians economists and cultural and ethnic studies scholars alongside contributions by photographers and journalists working in Los Angeles

Ethnic Los Angeles Roger Waldinger, Mehdi Bozorgmehr, 1996-12-05 Since 1965 more immigrants have come to Los Angeles than anywhere else in the United States These newcomers have rapidly and profoundly transformed the city s ethnic makeup and sparked heated debate over their impact on the region s troubled economy Ethnic Los Angeles presents a multi investigator study of L A s immigrant population exploring the scope characteristics and consequences of ethnic transition in the nation s second most populous urban center Using the wealth of information contained in the U S censuses of 1970 1980 and 1990 essays on each of L A s major ethnic groups tell who the immigrants are where they come from the skills they bring and their sources of employment and the nature of their families and social networks The contributors explain the history of legislation and economic change that made the city a magnet for immigration and compare the progress of new immigrants to those of previous eras Recent immigrants to Los Angeles follow no uniform course of adaptation nor do they simply assimilate into the mainstream society Instead they have entered into distinct niches at both the high and low ends of the

economic spectrum While Asians and Middle Easterners have thrived within the medical and technical professions low skill newcomers from Central America provide cheap labor in light manufacturing industries As Ethnic Los Angeles makes clear the city's future will depend both on how well its economy accommodates its diverse population and on how that population adapts to economic changes The more prosperous immigrants arrived already possessed of advanced educations and skills but what does the future hold for less skilled newcomers Will their children be able to advance socially and economically as the children of previous immigrants once did The contributors examine the effect of racial discrimination both in favoring low skilled immigrant job seekers over African Americans and in preventing the more successful immigrants and native born ethnic groups from achieving full economic parity with whites Ethnic Los Angeles is an illuminating portrait of a city whose unprecedented changes are sure to be replicated in other urban areas as new concentrations of immigrants develop Backed by detailed demographic information and insightful analyses this volume engages all of the issues that are central to today's debates about immigration ethnicity and economic opportunity in a post industrial urban society

Making Black Los Angeles Marne L. Campbell, 2016-09-27 Black Los Angeles started small The first census of the newly formed Los Angeles County in 1850 recorded only twelve Americans of African descent alongside a population of more than 3 500 Anglo Americans Over the following seventy years however the African American founding families of Los Angeles forged a vibrant community within the increasingly segregated and stratified city In this book historian Marne L Campbell examines the intersections of race class and gender to produce a social history of community formation and cultural expression in Los Angeles Expanding on the traditional narrative of middle class uplift Campbell demonstrates that the black working class largely through the efforts of women fought to secure their own economic and social freedom by forging communal bonds with black elites and other communities of color This women led black working class agency and cross racial community building Campbell argues was markedly more successful in Los Angeles than in any other region in the country Drawing from an extensive database of all African American households between 1850 and 1910 Campbell vividly tells the story of how middle class African Americans were able to live work and establish a community of their own in the growing city of Los Angeles

Adler,2001 On November 7 1967 the voters of Cleveland Ohio and Gary Indiana elected the nation s first African American mayors to govern their cities Ten years later more than two hundred black mayors held office and by 1993 sixty seven major urban centers most with majority white populations were headed by African Americans Once in office African American

mayors faced vexing challenges In large and small cities from the Sunbelt to the Rustbelt black mayors assumed office during economic downturns and confronted the intractable problems of decaying inner cities white flight a dwindling tax base violent crime and diminishing federal support for social programs Many encountered hostility from their own parties city councils and police departments others worked against long established power structures dominated by local business owners or politicians Still others while trying to respond to multiple demands from a diverse constituency were viewed as traitors by blacks expecting special attention from a leader of their own race All struggled with the contradictory mandate of meeting the increasing needs of poor inner city residents while keeping white businesses from fleeing to the suburbs This is the first comprehensive treatment of the complex phenomenon of African American mayors in the nation s major urban centers Offering a diverse portrait of leadership conflict and almost insurmountable obstacles this volume assesses the political alliances that brought black mayors to office as well as their accomplishments notably increased minority hiring and funding for minority businesses and the challenges that marked their careers Mayors profiled include Carl B Stokes Cleveland Richard G Hatcher Gary Dutch Morial New Orleans Harold Washington Chicago Tom Bradley Los Angeles Marion Barry Washington D C David Dinkins New York City Coleman Young Detroit and a succession of black mayors in Atlanta Maynard Jackson Andrew Young and Bill Campbell Probing the elusive economic dimension of black power African American Mayors demonstrates how the same circumstances that set the stage for the victories of black mayors exaggerated the obstacles they faced *Black Americans and the Civil Rights Movement in the West* Bruce A. Wintz, 2019-02-14 In 1927 Beatrice Cannady succeeded in removing racist language from the Oregon Constitution During World War II Rowena Moore fought for the right of black women to work in Omaha s meat packinghouses In 1942 Thelma Paige used the courts to equalize the salaries of black and white schoolteachers across Texas In 1950 Lucinda Todd of Topeka laid the groundwork for the landmark Supreme Court decision *Brown v Board of Education* These actions including sit ins long before the Greensboro sit ins of 1960 occurred well beyond the borders of the American South and East regions most known as the home of the civil rights movement By considering social justice efforts in western cities and states *Black Americans and the Civil Rights Movement in the West* convincingly integrates the West into the historical narrative of black Americans struggle for civil rights From Iowa and Minnesota to the Pacific Northwest and from Texas to the Dakotas black westerners initiated a wide array of civil rights activities in the early to late twentieth century Connected to national struggles as much as they were tailored to local situations these efforts predated or prefigured events in the East and South In this collection editors Bruce A Glasrud and Cary D Wintz bring these moments into sharp focus as the contributors note the ways in which the racial and ethnic diversity of the West shaped a specific kind of African American activism Concentrating on the far West the mountain states the desert Southwest the upper Midwest and states both southern and western the contributors examine black westerners responses to racism in its various manifestations whether as school

segregation in Dallas job discrimination in Seattle or housing bias in San Francisco Together their essays establish in unprecedented detail how efforts to challenge discrimination impacted and changed the West and ultimately the United States

Land of Smoke and Mirrors Vincent Brook, 2013-01-22 Unlike the more forthrightly mythic origins of other urban centers think Rome via Romulus and Remus or Mexico City via the god Huitzilopochtli Los Angeles emerged from a smoke and mirrors process that is simultaneously literal and figurative real and imagined material and metaphorical physical and textual Through penetrating analysis and personal engagement Vincent Brook uncovers the many portraits of this ever enticing ever ambivalent and increasingly multicultural megalopolis Divided into sections that probe Los Angeles's checkered history and reflect on Hollywood's own self-reflections the book shows how the city despite considerable remaining challenges is finally blowing away some of the smoke of its not always proud past and rhetorically adjusting its rear view mirrors Part I is a review of the city's history through the early 1900s focusing on the seminal 1884 novel *Ramona* and its immediate effect but also exploring its ongoing impact through interviews with present-day Tongva Indians attendance at the 88th annual *Ramona* pageant and analysis of its feature film adaptations Brook deals with Hollywood as geographical site film production center and frame of mind in Part II He charts the events leading up to Hollywood's emergence as the world's movie capital and explores subsequent developments of the film industry from its golden age through the so-called New Hollywood citing such self-reflexive films as *Sunset Blvd* *Singin' in the Rain* and *The Truman Show* Part III considers LA noir a subset of film noir that emerged alongside the classical noir cycle in the 1940s and 1950s and continues today The city's status as a privileged noir site is analyzed in relation to its history and through discussions of such key LA noir novels and films as *Double Indemnity* *Chinatown* and *Crash* In Part IV Brook examines multicultural Los Angeles Using media texts as signposts he maps the history and contemporary situation of the city's major ethno-racial and other minority groups looking at such films as *Mi Familia* *Latinos* *Boyz n the Hood* *African Americans* *Charlotte* *Sometimes Asians* *Falling Down* *Whites* and *The Kids Are All Right* LGBT
