

Reframing Black Perspectives in Social Work: New Directions?

Mekada Graham

This paper aims to focus on the politics of exclusion by opening up a debate about black perspectives in social work and articulates a comparative argument between the UK and USA, which includes contributions from social and political theory, particularly the 'politics of recognition'. The paper begins by mapping the territory discussed in the growth of 'studies' in sociology and academia. Following these discussions, I review criticisms and possibilities of anti-racist social work and black perspectives to argue that in the British context, the dilation of anti-racist social work into a discriminatory practice framework undermined the place of black perspectives in social work education. In the next section, a reframing of black perspectives is envisaged with implications for social work learning and practice. By attending to these issues, social work learning and practice can support a more inclusive approach to professional knowledge which recognises changing patterns of social life, complexity and multiple perspectives.

Introduction

Social work has long attended to issues of social exclusion and discrimination of vulnerable populations in society. Indeed, social work has adopted social justice as an important aspect of its mission and guide for practice to tackle widespread inequalities across social areas. Marginalised groups experience different forms of exclusion from material deprivation to lack of recognition, misrecognition and respect when others very little weight is given to their voices, concerns and experiences.

With these concerns in mind, there has been a growing body of literature that seeks to address many forms of discrimination and inequalities through integrating theories and practice principles into social work. This broad range of theories includes radical, structural, feminist, anti-racist, anti-oppressive and
