Madison Avenue and the Color Line Jason Chambers, 2011-08-24 Until now most works on the history of African Americans in advertising have focused on the depiction of blacks in advertisements As the first comprehensive examination of African American participation in the industry Madison Avenue and the Color Line breaks new ground by examining the history of black advertising employees and agency owners For much of the twentieth century even as advertisers chased African American consumer dollars the doors to most advertising agencies were firmly closed to African American professionals Over time black participation in the industry resulted from the combined efforts of black media civil rights groups black consumers government organizations and black advertising and marketing professionals working outside white agencies Blacks positioned themselves for jobs within the advertising industry especially as experts on the black consumer market and then used their status to alter stereotypical perceptions of black consumers By doing so they became part of the broader effort to build an African American professional and entrepreneurial class and to challenge the negative portrayals of blacks in American culture Using an extensive review of advertising trade journals government documents and organizational papers as well as personal interviews and the advertisements themselves Jason Chambers weaves individual biographies together with broader events in U S history to tell how blacks struggled to bring equality to the advertising industry **Advertising Revolutionary** Jason P. Jean-Olivier Tchouaffe, 2025-06-15 Talking to the Dead is an exhaustive spectrum of a diasporic cinematic corpus of prophetic tradition as a dispositive that features the work of underrepresented and underestimated filmmakers such as Jean Pierre Bekolo Ladj Ly Mati Diop Wanuri Kahiu Rosine Mbakam Ryan Coogler Alice Diop Nana Mensah Gina Prince Bythehood Nikyatu Jusu Raoul Peck Miryam Charles Ellie Fombi Tracy Heather Strain Jordan Peele Sheila S Walker Margaret Brown Pierre Yves Borgeaud Rachid Hami and Abderrahmane Sissako and the homology between the black experience and the law of the conservation of energy where nothing is lost but constantly transformed The black energy's metaphor functions as the infinite possibility of black historical subjectivity that defines modernity as an accumulation of events that structure the connection of the past to the present and vice versa In short how these processes that shape the diasporic filmmakers' artistic sovereignty as a critical praxis of creativity and re-subjectification mapping out a geography of the black diasporic memorial trajectories and cultural imagination to demonstrate the power to break out of disciplinary discourse of coloniality and violent policing of black lives *Frontline Bodies* Nicolas Martin-Breteau, 2024-04-16 A captivating exploration of Black American civil rights activism through the lens of sport In Frontline Bodies Nicolas Martin Breteau argues that sports are not and have never been purely about entertainment for Black Americans Instead beginning in the 1890s during Reconstruction Black Americans proactively used athletics as a tactic to fight racial oppression Since the body was the primary target of anti Black racial oppression African Americans turned sports into a key medium in their struggles for dignity equality and justice Although Black photography and art also aimed at displaying the dignity of the Black body sports arguably had the greatest impact on American and international public opinion Martin Breteau considers the work of Edwin B Henderson a prominent Black physical educator civil rights activist and historian of Black sports Training Black children as athletes Henderson felt would work both to fortify racial pride and to dismantle racial prejudices two necessary requirements for a successful political liberation struggle In this way physical education became political education By the end of World War II the tactic of racial uplift through sports had reached its peak of popularity only to subsequently lose its appeal among younger activists many of whom believed that the strategy was ineffective in fighting institutional racism and served mainly as an emulation of middle class white norms By the end of the twentieth century Martin Breteau argues racial uplift through sports had lost its emancipating power The emphasis on the accumulation of wealth for professional athletes as well as sports ability to reinforce anti Black stereotypes had become a political problem for true collective liberation For a marginalized group of people that has been physically excluded from the democratic process however sports remain a political resource By studying

the relationship between athletics and politics Frontline Bodies renews the history of minority bodies and their power of action

Cutting a Figure Richard J. Powell, 2008 Examining portraits of black people over the past two centuries Cutting a Figure argues that these images should be viewed as a distinct category of portraiture that differs significantly from depictions of people with other racial and ethnic backgrounds The difference Richard Powell contends lies in the social capital that stems directly from the black subject's power to subvert dominant racist representations by evincing such traits as self composure self adornment and self imagining Powell forcefully supports this argument with evidence drawn from a survey of nineteenth century portraits in depth case studies of the postwar fashion model Donyale Luna and the contemporary portraitist Barkley L Hendricks and insightful analyses of images created since the late 1970s Along the way he discusses major artists such as Fr d ric Bazille John Singer Sargent James Van Der Zee and David Hammons alongside such overlooked producers of black visual culture as the Tonka and Nike corporations Combining previously unpublished images with scrupulous archival research Cutting a Figure illuminates the ideological nature of the genre and the centrality of race and cultural identity in understanding modern and contemporary portraiture

Represented Brenna Wynn Greer, 2019-07-12 In 1948 Moss Kendrix a former New Deal public relations officer founded a highly successful Washington D C based public relations firm the flagship client of which was the Coca Cola Company As the first black pitchman for Coca Cola Kendrix found his way into the rarefied world of white corporate America His personal phone book also included the names of countless black celebrities such as bandleader Duke Ellington singer actress Pearl Bailey and boxer Joe Louis with whom he had built relationships in the course of developing marketing campaigns for his numerous federal and corporate clients Kendrix along with Ebony publisher John H Johnson and Life photographer Gordon Parks recognized that in the image saturated world of postwar America media in all its forms held greater significance for defining American citizenship than ever before For these imagemakers the visual representation of African Americans as good citizens was good business In Represented Brenna Wynn Greer explores how black entrepreneurs produced magazines photographs and advertising that forged a close association between blackness and Americanness In particular they popularized conceptions of African Americans as enthusiastic consumers a status essential to postwar citizenship claims But their media creations were complicated subject to marketplace dictates they often relied on gender class and family stereotypes Demand for such representations came not only from corporate and government clients to fuel mass consumerism and attract support for national efforts such as the fight against fascism but also from African Americans who sought depictions of blackness to counter racist ideas that undermined their rights and their national belonging as citizens The story of how black capitalists
