Black Manhattan:

Black City Cinema Paula Massood, 2003-01-22 In *Black City Cinema* Paula Massood shows how popular films reflected the massive social changes that resulted from the Great Migration of African Americans from the rural South to cities in the North West and Mid West during the first three decades of the twentieth century By the onset of the Depression the Black population had become primarily urban transforming individual lives as well as urban experience and culture Massood probes into the relationship of place and time showing how urban settings became an intrinsic element of African American film as Black people became more firmly rooted in urban spaces and more visible as historical and political subjects Illuminating the intersections of film history politics and urban discourse she considers the chief genres of African American and Hollywood narrative film the black cast musicals of the 1920s and the race films of the early sound era to blaxploitation and hood films as well as the work of Spike Lee toward the end of the century As it examines such a wide range of films over much of the twentieth century this book offers a unique map of Black representations in film *In The Company Of Black Men* Craig Steven Wilder, 2002-02-01 Traces the development of African American community traditions over three centuries From the subaltern assemblies of the enslaved in colonial New York City to the benevolent New York African Society of the early national era to the formation of the African Blood Brotherhood in twentieth century Harlem voluntary associations have been a fixture of African American communities In the *Company of Black Men* examines New York City over three centuries to show that enslaved Africans provided the institutional foundation upon which African American religious political and social culture could flourish Arguing that the universality of the voluntary tradition in African American communities has its basis in collectivism a behavioral and rhetorical tendency to privilege the group over the individual it explores the institutions that arose as enslaved Africans exploited the potential for group action and mass resistance Craig Steven Wilder's research is particularly exciting in its assertion that Africans entered the Americas equipped with intellectual traditions and sociological models that facilitated a communitarian response to oppression Presenting a dramatic shift from previous work which has viewed African American male associations as derivative and imitative of white male counterparts In the *Company of Black Men* provides a ground breaking template for investigating antebellum black institutions *Black Recording Artists, 1877-1926* , 2013-01-03 This annotated discography covers the first 50 years of audio recordings by black artists in chronological order music made in the acoustic era of recording technology The book has cross referenced bibliographical information on recording sessions including audio sources for extant material and appendices on field recordings Caribbean Mexican and South American recordings piano rolls performed by black artists and a filmography detailing the visual record of black performing artists from the period Indexes contain all featured artists titles recorded and labels *African American Literature in Transition, 1920-1930: Volume 9* Miriam Thaggert, Rachel Farebrother, 2022-04-07 This book analyses historical literary and cultural shifts in African American literature from the 1920s 1930s **James Weldon Johnson's**

Modern Soundscapes Noelle Morrisette, 2013-05 In this groundbreaking work literary critic Noelle Morrisette examines how his literary representation of the extremes of sonic experience functioning as either cultural violence or creative force draws attention to the mutual contingencies and the interdependence of American and African American cultures Moreover Morrisette argues Johnson represented these American sounds as a source of multiplicity and diversity often developing a framework for the interracial transfer of sound The lyricist and civil rights leader used sound as a formal aesthetic practice in and between his works presenting it as an unbounded cultural practice that is as much an interracial as it is a racially distinct cultural history Drawing on archival materials such as early manuscript notes and drafts of Johnson's unpublished and published work Morrisette explores the author's complex aesthetic of sound based on black expressive culture and cosmopolitan interracial experiences

Blood Relations Irma Watkins-Owens, 1996-03-22. In *Blood Relations*, Irma Watkins-Owens focuses on the complex interaction of African Americans and African Caribbeans in Harlem during the first decades of the 20th century. Between 1900 and 1930, 40,000 Caribbean immigrants settled in New York City and joined with African Americans to create the unique ethnic community of Harlem. Watkins-Owens confronts issues of Caribbean immigrant and black American relations, placing their interaction in the context of community formation. She draws the reader into a cultural milieu that included the radical tradition of stepladder speaking, Marcus Garvey's contentious leadership, the underground numbers operations of Caribbean

immigrant entrepreneurs and the literary renaissance and emergence of black journalists Through interviews census data and biography Watkins Owens shows how immigrants and southern African American migrants settled together in railroad flats and brownstones worked primarily at service occupations often lodged with relatives or home people and strove to make it in New York
