*Black Freedom Fighters in Steel* Ruth Needleman, 2003 Thousands of African Americans poured into northwest Indiana in the 1920s dreaming of decent paying jobs and a life without Klansmen chain gangs and cotton Black Freedom Fighters in Steel The Struggle for Democratic Unionism by Ruth Needleman adds a new dimension to the literature on race and labor It tells the story of five men born in the South who migrated north for a chance to work the dirtiest and most dangerous jobs in the steel mills Individually they fought for equality and justice collectively they helped construct economic and union democracy in postwar America George Kimbley the oldest grew up in Kentucky across the street from the family who had owned his parents He fought with a French regiment in World War I and then settled in Gary Indiana in 1920 to work in steel He joined the Steelworkers Organizing Committee and became the first African American member of its full time staff in 1938 The youngest Jonathan Comer picked cotton on his father s land in Alabama stood up to racism in the military during World War II and became the first African American to be president of a basic steel local union This is a book about the integration of unions as well as about five remarkable individuals It focuses on the decisive role of African American leaders in building interracial unionism One chapter deals with the African American struggle for representation highlighting the importance of independent black organization within the union Needleman also presents a conversation among two pioneering steelworkers and current African American union leaders about the racial politics of union activism

Du Bois's Twilight Years** Phillip Luke Sinitiere, 2023-06-23 Contributions by Murali Balaji Charisse Burden Stelly Christopher Cameron Carlton Dwayne Floyd Robert Greene II Andre E Johnson Werner Lange Lisa J McLeod Jodi Melamed Tyler Monson Eric Porter Reiland Rabaka Thomas Ehrlich Reifer Camesha Scruggs and Phillip Luke Sinitiere Although the career of W E B Du Bois was remarkable in its entirety a large majority of scholarship focuses on the first five or six decades Overlooked and understudied the closing three decades of Du Bois s career reflect a generative period of his life in terms of teaching travel activism and publications Forging Freedom in W E B Du Bois s Twilight Years No Deed but Memory proposes to narrate the political social and cultural significance of Du Bois s career during the controversial closing three decades of his life Du Bois s twilight years were tremendously controversial his persistent criticism of the collusion between capitalism and racism and his choice to join the Communist Party in late 1961 raised the ire of many At the time Du Bois s strident advocacy of socialism and turn to communism during the Cold War oriented most scholars away from delving into his late career While only a few scholars have engaged the productivity of Du Bois s later years the fact is that an anticommunist antiradical animus has followed Du Bois in the half century since his death As a result Du Bois scholarship remains impoverished to the extent that academics neglect his later years The essays in Forging Freedom in W E B Du Bois s Twilight Years detail selected aspects of Du Bois s later decades and their particular connection to American social political and cultural history between the 1930s and the 1960s While international concerns and a global perspective also fundamentally defined Du Bois s latter years chronicling his final decades in a US context presents fresh insight into his twilight years Du Bois s commitment to freedom s flourishing during this period animated the Black freedom struggle s war against white supremacy Ultimately this book demonstrates that the durability of Du Bois s intellectual achievements remains relevant to the twenty first century

**Teklife, Ghettoville, Eski** Dhanveer Singh Brar, 2021-04-27 How black electronic dance music makes it possible to reorganize life within the contemporary city Teklife Ghettoville Eski argues that Black electronic dance music produces sonic ecologies of Blackness that expose and reorder the contemporary racialization of the urban ecologies that can never simply be reduced to their geographical and racial context Dhanveer Singh Brar makes the case for Black electronic dance music as the cutting edge aesthetic project of the diaspora which due to the music's class character makes it possible to reorganize life within the contemporary city Closely analysing the Footwork scene in South and West Chicago the Grime scene in East London and the output of the South London producer Actress Brar pays attention to the way each of these critically acclaimed musical projects experiment with aesthetic form through an experimentation of the social Through explicitly theoretical means Teklife Ghettoville Eski foregrounds the sonic specificity of 12 records EPs albums radio broadcasts and recorded performances to make the case that Footwork Grime and Actress dissolve racialized spatial constraints that are thought to surround Black social life Pushing the critical debates concerning the phonic materiality of blackness undercommons and aesthetic sociality in new directions Teklife Ghettoville Eski rethinks these concepts through concrete examples of contemporary black electronic dance music production that allows for a theorization of the way Footwork Grime and Actress have through their experiments in blackness generated genuine alternatives to the functioning of the city under financialized racial capitalism



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
