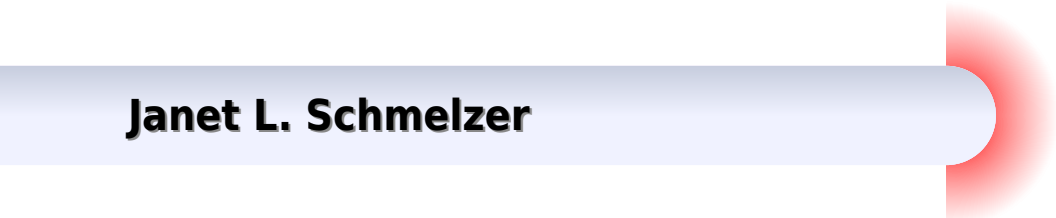

Glasrud, James Smallwood, 2007 The African American Experience in Texas collects for the first time the finest historical research and writing on African Americans in Texas Covering the time period between 1820 and the late 1970s the selections highlight the significant role that black Texans played in the development of the state Topics include politics slavery religion military experience segregation and discrimination civil rights women education and recreation This anthology provides new insights into a previously neglected part of American history and is essential reading for anyone interested in the history of black Texans African Americans and Race Relations in San Antonio, Texas, 1867-1937 Kenneth Mason, 1998 This is a study of how paternal race relations in San Antonio contributed to the rise of accommodation minded African American leaders whose successful manipulation of the political and ethnic divisions provided goods services and sustained voting rights during a period when African Americans throughout the South had lost such privileges The unique demography of Mexican German Anglo and African Americans a service based economy of hotels restaurants and saloons and campaigns by white civic leaders to make San Antonio the premier commercial and vacation center of the Southwest nurtured a political machine that intended to keep blacks in their place This resulted in an assortment of Jim Crow laws restrictive employment opportunities and segregated schools parks and municipal services albeit without mob lynching and racial violence This paternal brand of racism resulted in the rise of one of the most powerful black political bosses of his time Charles Bellinger Challenges from conservative white reformers and disgruntled black civil rights advocates failed to dislodge the hold Bellinger's machine had on the black community and the city until the Great Depression By examining employment education politics and socio cultural activities that contributed to the city's unique race relations the study takes a hard look at whether separate but equal ever become a reality in San Antonio Blacks in East Texas History Bruce A. Glasrud, Archie P. During a five-year period in the field, Pitts played the piano at and recorded numerous worship services in black Baptist churches throughout rural Texas. His historical comparisons and linguistic analyses of this material uncover striking parallels between Afro-Baptist services and the religious rituals of Western and Central Africa, as well as other African-derived rituals in the United States, the Sea Islands, the Caribbean, and Brazil. Pitts demonstrates that African and African American worship share an underlying binary ritual frame: the somber melancholy of the first frame and the high emotion of

the second frame Pitts's revealing perspective on this often misunderstood aspect of African American religion provides an investigative model for the study of diaspora cultural practices and the residual influence of their African sources

Imagining the African American West Blake Allmendinger, 2005-01-01 The literature of the African American West is the last racial discourse of the region that remains unexplored Blake Allmendinger addresses this void in literary and cultural studies with *Imagining the African American West* the first comprehensive study of African American literature on the early frontier and in the modern urban American West Allmendinger charts the terrain of African American literature in the West through his exploration of novels histories autobiographies science fiction mysteries formula westerns melodramas experimental theater and political essays as well as rap music and film He examines the histories of James P. Beckwourth and Oscar Micheaux slavery the Civil War and the significance of the American frontier to blacks and the Harlem Renaissance the literature of urban unrest rap music black noir and African American writers including Toni Morrison and Walter Mosley His study utilizes not only the works of well known African American writers but also some obscure and neglected works out of print books and unpublished manuscripts in library archives Much of the scholarly neglect of the Black West can be blamed on how the American West has been imagined constructed and framed in scholarship to date In his study Allmendinger provides the appropriate theoretical cultural and historical contexts for understanding the literature and suggests new directions for the future of black western literature

What Comes Naturally Peggy Pascoe, 2009 A long awaited history that promises to dramatically change our understanding of race in America *What Comes Naturally* traces the origins spread and demise of miscegenation laws in the United States laws that banned interracial marriage and sex most often between whites and members of other races Peggy Pascoe demonstrates how these laws were enacted and applied not just in the South but throughout most of the country in the West the North and the Midwest Beginning in the Reconstruction era when the term miscegenation first was coined she traces the creation of a racial hierarchy that bolstered white supremacy and banned the marriage of Whites to Chinese Japanese Filipinos and American Indians as well as the marriage of Whites to Blacks She ends not simply with the landmark 1967 case of *Loving v. Virginia* in which the Supreme Court finally struck down miscegenation laws throughout the country but looks at the implications of ideas of colorblindness that replaced them *What Comes Naturally* is both accessible to the general reader and informative to the specialist a rare feat for an original work of history based on archival research

The Odyssey of Texas Ranger James Callahan Joseph Luther, 2017-04-17 James Callahan entered Texas armed a quixotic young man enlisted in the Georgia Battalion for the cause of independence He barely survived the 1836 Battle of Refugio and the Goliad Massacre Undaunted by the perils of his adopted home he remained in the line of fire for the next twenty one years fighting to protect Texas settlers from Apaches Comanches Seminoles Kickapoos outlaws mavericks and the Mexican army As a Texas Ranger he rode with the legendary men of Seguin and San Antonio In 1855 he commanded the punitive expedition into Mexico that bears his name a fiasco that has been

shrouded by mystery and shadowed by controversy ever since In this first ever biography Joseph Luther traces the tragic course of the wayfarer who crossed so much of the Texas frontier and created so much of its story **In Search of Canaan** Robert G. Athearn,2021-10-08 Word spread across the southern farm country and into the minds of those who labored over cotton or sugar crops that the day of reckoning was near at hand that the Lord hand answered black prayers with the offer of deliverance in a western Eden In this vast state where Brown had caused blood to flow in his righteous wrath there was said to be land for all and land especially for poor blacks who for so long had cherished the thought of a tiny patch of America that they could call their own The soil was said to be free for the taking and even better passage to the prairie Canaan was rumored to be available to all Thus began a pell mell land rush to Kansas an unreasoned almost mindless exodus from the South toward some vague ideal some western paradise where all cares would vanish In a vigorous reasoned style Robert G Athearn tells the story of the Black migration from areas of the South to Kansas and other midwestern and western states that occurred soon after the end of Reconstruction Working almost entirely from primary sources letters of some of the Black migrants government investigative reports and Black newspapers he describes and explains the Exoduster movement and sets it into perspective as a phenomenon in frontier history The book begins with details of the Exodusters on the move Athearn then fills in the background of why they were moving relates how other people Black and white Northern and Southern felt about the movement examines political considerations and finally evaluates the episode and provides an explanation as to why it failed According to Athearn the exodus spoke in a narrower sense of Black emigrants who sought frontier farms but in the main it told more about a nation whose wounds had been bound but had not yet healed The Republicans without any issues of consequence in 1880 gave the flight national importance in the hope that it would gain votes for them and at the same time reduce the South s population and hence its representation in Congress Thousands of Black Americans many of them former slaves were deluded by false promises made by individual interests As the hawkers of glad tidings beckoned to the easily convinced the word Kansas became equated with the word freedom Emotional often biblical overtones gave the movement millenarian flavor and Kansas became the unwilling focus of a revitalized national campaign for Black rights Athearn describes the social political economic and even agricultural difficulties that blacks had in adapting to white culture He evaluates the activities of black leaders such as Benjamin Pap Singleton northern politicians such as Kansas Governor John P St John and refugee aid organizations such as the Kansas Freedmen s Relief Association He tells the Exoduster story not just as a southern story the turmoil in Dixie and flight from the scenes of a struggle but especially as a western story a meaningful segment of the history of a frontier state His remarkably objective as well as suspenseful account of this unusual episodes contributes significantly to Kansas history to western history and to the history of Black people in America **Blacks in Niagara Falls** Michael B. Boston,2021-08-16 Blacks in Niagara Falls narrates and analyzes the history of Black Niagarans from the days of the Underground Railroad to the Age of Urban Renewal Michael B
